24	expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and
25	WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time
26	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and
27 28 29	WHEREAS , the City Administration proposes that the FY 2021-2022 adopted budget be amended to include the following transactions:
30 31 32 33	 Sophos Antivirus Subscription – \$19,004. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves;
