RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PIGGYBACK OF THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE CONTRACT # 19053JLS WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS INC., TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT, SERVICE INTEGRATION AND INSTALLATION OF AN ADDITIONAL FOUR (4) AUTOMATOC LICENSE PLATE READER (ALPR) LOCATIONS, IN ADDITION TO FORTY-NINE (49) PUBLIC SAFETY CAMERA (CCTV) AND FOUR (4) SERVERS WITH ACCOMPANYING HARDWARE AT TWELVE (12) NEW EXPANDED LOCATIONS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE (\$732,359) DOLLARS, FOR A TOTAL TERM OF FIVE YEARS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (6), Exception to Bid Requirements, and Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchase, the City Manager is authorized to procure supplies, materials, equipment, and services from contracts of other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be served subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval: and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the License Plate Recognition cameras has served as a deterrent to crime and as a forensic tool to solve crimes after they occur. The cameras have also assisted in the effectuating arrests as a result of the alerts from the cameras; and

WHEREAS, staff seeks City Commission approval to expand the Automatic License Plate Recognition (ALPR) cameras and the Public Safety Camera (CCTV) system utilizing the Broward Sheriff's Office Contract No. RLI #19053JLS; and

39 **WHEREAS**, staff seeks to install an additional four (4) ALPRs locations, in addition
40 to forty-nine (49) CCTV and four (4) servers with accompanying hardware at twelve (12)
41 new locations; and

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43 **WHEREAS**, in FY2020-2021, the Hallandale Beach Police Department (HBPD)
44 partnered with the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency and was
45 awarded grant funding from the Department of Justice to implement several crime fighting
46 initiatives to include the installation of an ALPR's system at all the major traffic arteries
47 into the City; and

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49 **WHEREAS**, currently the City of Hallandale Beach has seventeen (17) ALPR
50 locations at all the major intersections entering the City as well as the two (2) Safe
51 Neighborhood Districts; and

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53 **WHEREAS**, funding for the CCTV and LPR cameras is derived from a combination
54 of accounts. The HBCRA ILA provides Five Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Three
55 Hundred and Eight Dollars (\$593,308) and One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Six Hundred
56 Dollars (\$156,600) is allocated through the Smart Policing Initiatives (SPI) grant; and

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58 **WHEREAS**, HBPD recommends City Commission authorization to piggyback the
59 Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # 19053JLS with Motorola Solutions Inc., to purchase
60 equipment, service integration and installation of the additional four (4) ALPRs locations,
61 in addition to forty-nine (49) CCTV and four (4) servers with accompanying hardware at
62 twelve (12) new locations for an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Thirty-Two
63 Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Nine (\$732,359) Dollars. Staff anticipates additional
64 annual costs for maintenance not to exceed City Manager expenditure thresholds.

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66 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
67 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

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69 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY**
70 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

71 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
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SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the piggyback of the Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # 19053JLS with Motorola Solutions Inc., to purchase equipment, service integration and installation of the additional four (4) ALPRs locations, in addition to forty-nine (49) CCTV and four (4) servers with accompanying hardware at twelve (12) new locations for an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Nine (\$732,359) Dollars, for a total term of five years. City Manager is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the purchases.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
