4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA URGING THE USE OF MAJOR ROADWAYS IN THE REDISTRICTING PROCESS FOR THE BROWARD COUNTY COMMISSION TO MAINTAIN A GREATER DEGREE OF REPRESENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
12	WHEREAS, Broward County is redrawing County Commission districts to
13	accommodate population shifts shown in the 2020 U.S. Census; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, Fair District Standards adopted in 2018 require districts to not be
16	drawn to favor or disfavor any political party or incumbent, should protect minority racial
17	or language populations, be contiguous, as compact as possible, respect existing
18	geographic and community boundaries as much as possible, and be as equal in
19	population as practicable; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, in considering whether to follow municipal or main roadway and other
22	geographic boundaries, the City of Hallandale Beach recognizes that municipalities can
23	incorporate a number of varied and diverse communities that often have varied interests
24	and concerns; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, exclusive or primary use of municipal boundaries to redistrict would
27	negatively impact representation for all communities by drowning out interests of
28	communities united in concerns not affecting other parts of their municipality; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, representation of concerns shared in common throughout
31	municipalities is already achieved through municipal elected officials and their ability to
32	amplify the common concerns of their residents; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe that it is in the best interest
35	of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to urge Broward County to utilize major
36	roadways and other geographic boundaries to maximize representation for all
37	communities in the redistricting process.

39	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
40	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

42	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
43	
44	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby urge Broward County to
45	utilize major roadways and other geographic boundaries to maximize representation for
46	all communities in the redistricting process. The City Clerk is directed to transmit this
47	resolution to all appropriate entities.

49	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
50	its passage and adoption.
