3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH AND THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR PROVISION AND ADMINISTRATION OF A LOAN TO PINNACLE AT AUDUBON PLACE, LLLP, A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AND/OR ITS AFFILIATES, IN THE AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$640,000.00) FOR DEVELOPMENT OF AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FOR SENIORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
L6 L7	WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (HBCRA) is
18	dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for its residents; and
L9	WHEREAS, the HBCRA intends to partner with Pinnacle at Audubon Place, LLLP (the
20	"Developer") in the development of a mixed-use development known as "Pinnacle at Audubon
21	Place" (the "Project"), located at 219 West Pembroke Road within the City of Hallandale
22	Beach ("City"); and
23	WHEREAS, the project will consist of 116 multifamily units designated for seniors
24	aged sixty-two (62) and older with incomes at or below sixty percent (60%) of the area median
25	income (AMI) for a minimum of fifty (50) years; and
26	WHEREAS, the Developer aims to secure Low Income Housing Tax Credits through
27	the Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC); and
28	WHEREAS, the HBCRA has requested that the City partner with HBCRA and the
29	Developer on the Project, with the HBCRA, through the City, providing a forgivable loan to
30	Developer in an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars
31	(\$640,000.00), contingent upon Developer securing an award of Low Income Housing Tax
32	Credits through FHFC; and
33	WHEREAS, the loan will constitute the City's local support under Florida Housing's
34	"Local Government Area of Opportunity" guidelines, and will be the only such designated 1 RESO NO. 2025-

35	development by the City for the next two (2) years of Florida Housing application cycles for
36	9% Low Income Housing Tax Credits; and
37	WHEREAS, the HBCRA will administer the loan on behalf of the City and
38	coordinate closely on all aspects of the Project's funding; and
39	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission consider and
40	approve the proposed loan by the City to Developer for the proposed project.
41	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
42	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

44	SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby adopted
45	herein.
46 47	SECTION 2. Approval of Interlocal Agreement. The Mayor and City Commission
48	hereby approve an Interlocal Agreement between the HBCRA and the City related to
49	provision and administration of a loan in the amount of Six Hundred Forty Thousand and
50	00/100 Dollars (\$640,000.00), to Pinnacle at Audubon Place, LLLP, or its affiliates, for the
51	Project, subject to an award of Low Income Housing Tax Credits from the Florida Housing
52	Finance Corporation.
53	
54	SECTION 3. Authority of City Manager. The City Manager is hereby authorized to
55	execute the Interlocal Agreement attached as Exhibit "A" hereto and to take all steps
56	necessary and appropriate to implement the terms and conditions of the Interlocal
57	Agreement.
58	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
59	passage and adoption.
