**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE'S CONTRACT ITB# 12690-022 WITH TROPIC FENCE, INC. TO INSTALL NEW PERIMETER FENCING AT JOSEPH SCAVO PARK FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED, FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$147,472); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

16           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,  
17 Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; procurement mechanisms,  
18 Subsection (4) Piggybacking, the City may procure goods or services from vendors  
19 who have been selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another  
20 governmental entity if the selection process utilized by the contracting entity was  
21 substantially similar to the requirements of the City, and the goods or services  
22 procured by the City are procured pursuant to the original contract scope and terms;

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25           **WHEREAS**, as part of the FY2025 budget process, Joseph Scavo Park  
26 perimeter fencing was approved as a Capital Improvement Project; and  
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28           **WHEREAS**, Parks and Recreation staff identified various portions of private  
29 fencing encroaching on City property for removal and replace the current Park  
30 fencing with continuous six-foot (6') alternate board wood fence along the North,  
31 East and South boundaries, and Ascott Aluminum fencing along the West boundary;

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34           **WHEREAS**, Tropic Fence, Inc., a vendor contracted with the City of Ft.  
35 Lauderdale through ITB# 12690-022, has proposed to install new perimeter fencing at  
36 Joseph Scavo Park for a total amount not to exceed One Hundred, Forty-Seven  
37 Thousand, Four Hundred and Seventy-Two Dollars (\$147,472); and  
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39           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to  
40 be in the public interest to authorize utilization of the City of Fort Lauderdale’s contract  
41 ITB# 12690-022 with Tropic Fence, Inc. to install new perimeter fencing at Joseph  
42 Scavo Park for a not to exceed amount of One Hundred, Forty-Seven Thousand, Four  
43 Hundred and Seventy-Two Dollars (\$147,472), and authorize the City Manager to  
44 execute relating documents.

54 Park for a not to exceed amount of One Hundred, Forty-Seven Thousand, Four  
55 Hundred and Seventy-Two Dollars (\$147,472), and authorize the City Manager to  
56 execute relating documents.
