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WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Sec. 28-3 (5), Unique circumstances, of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances provides an exception to the completive bidding requirement where the City Commission finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City; however, such purchases in excess of \$50,000 shall require a formal, written contract approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently encountering an unprecedented number of water meters that are not transmitting electronic reads or the electronic read is inaccurate. This has resulted in a significant increase in the number of manual reads in the field, meter maintenance work orders created, and estimated meter reads for billing purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department is seeking approval for continued temporary
staffing services with Robert Half International, Inc. that will exceed the City Manager's
threshold to assist the Utility Billing Division with additional staffing needs during the
implementation of the city-wide AMI Meter Remediation Project; and

WHEREAS, due to the continuing AMI Project, we are requesting that the Robert
Half services be retained for one year to ensure continuity of operations in the Utility Billing
Division; and

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34 WHEREAS, over the next twelve-month period, City administration expects to replace 35 an additional 4,500 meters, including warranty replacement meters currently on hand

pursuant to a settlement agreement, and believes that continued Robert Half staffing for this 36 final year will ensure continuation of operations, accurate and timely billing during the meter 37 change outs, and a seamless transition during the City's full meter upgrade; and 38

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40 WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public interest to authorize a change order, pursuant to Sec. 28-3 (5) of the City Code, Unique 41 Circumstances, for FY 2024-25 of temporary staffing services from Robert Half International, 42 Inc. in a not to exceed amount of Two Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$220,000) to 43 ensure a seamless transition during the City's full water meter upgrade, and authorize the 44 45 City Manager to execute relating documents.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA: 48

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SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its 59 60 passage and adoption.
