55	Commission hereby approve the renewal of the City's workers' compensation
56	insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund in the estimated amount
57	of one hundred fifty-two thousand three hundred eighteen (\$152,318) dollars as
58	provided for in fiscal year 2023-24 budget, subject to the adjustment resulting from the
59	required annual audit and authorizing the City Manager to execute all related
60	documents to effectuate the renewal of the City's workers' compensation insurance.
61 62	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect
63	immediately upon its passage and adoption.
