AFTER ACTION REPORT

Scavo Park Electric Bike Initiative

Background

Concerns were raised regarding the use of electric bikes at Scavo Park and their impact on safety and compliance with applicable laws. In response, the Department implemented a coordinated plan that combined increased enforcement with community education.

Actions Implemented

Enhanced Patrol Coverage

- Extra patrol units were assigned to Scavo Park on Monday, September 15, 2025, and Tuesday, September 16, 2025.
- Officers actively monitored the area, addressed violations, and engaged riders on compliance.

Educational Outreach Campaign

- An informational table was set up in the park, where officers distributed flyers detailing electric bike laws, safety protocols, and park regulations.
- Department social media accounts reinforced the messaging, ensuring citywide awareness.

Helmet and Safety Gear Distribution

- Free helmets were provided to riders during the educational event.
- This effort promoted safe riding practices and underscored the Department's commitment to proactive community safety.

Event Success

The Department successfully hosted a community educational event at Scavo Park. Residents engaged with officers, received safety information, and took part in helmet distribution. The positive turnout demonstrated strong community interest and reinforced the Department's role as both an enforcer of laws and an educator for safe practices.

Summary

The combined approach of enforcement and education addressed immediate safety concerns while fostering long-term awareness. Increased patrols ensured compliance, and the educational campaign, supported by printed materials, helmet distribution, and upcoming social media outreach, reinforced the Department's dedication to both safety and community engagement.
