6 AWARDED A CONTRACT FOR SCHAFER CANAL
7 RESTORATION PROJECT, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE
8 BIDDING DUE TO NO BIDS HAVING BEEN RECEIVED TO
9 BID # FY2021-2022-018, TO B&Z CONSTRUCTION, LLC, IN
10 AN AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-
11 SIX THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,386,500)
12 AND AUTHORIZE A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR A TOTAL NOT
13 TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED
14 TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY
15 DOLLARS (\$1,525,150); AND PROVIDING FOR AN
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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19 **WHEREAS**, to mitigate flooding in the City and improve quality of life, City staff
20 routinely maintain the stormwater storage and conveyance systems comprised of catch
21 basins, ponds, storm drains, pump stations, injection wells, outfalls, canals, etc. in the
22 Southwest (SW) quadrant of the City, and most of the stormwater collected is conveyed to
23 the Schaffer Canal, which flows south to the Intracoastal waterways via Miami Dade County;

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26 **WHEREAS**, a significant amount of sediment has accumulated in the Canal, severely
27 reducing its capacity to handle floodwater, and Staff is concerned with erosion along the canal
28 banks, recommending immediate dredging of the Canal; and
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30 **WHEREAS**, on July 5, 2022, the City released Bid # FY2021-2022-018 - Schaffer
31 Canal Restoration Project for dredging of the Schaffer Canal at an estimated construction
32 cost of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000); and
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34 **WHEREAS**, there were no bids received for this project; and
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36 **WHEREAS**, Sec. 23-8 (4) of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances follows
37 Sec. 255.20, F.S., carving out an exception to the requirement of competitive solicitation
38 where no bids have been received after publication of a bid proposal; subject to a

noncompetitive bid in excess of \$50,000 requiring a formal, written contract approved by the City commission; and

WHEREAS, Staff received a proposal from B&Z Construction, LLC for One Million Three Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,386,500,); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to award a contract for Schaffer Canal Restoration Project, without competitive bidding due to no bids having been received to Bid # FY2021-2022-018 -, to B&Z Construction, LLC for One Million Three Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,386,500,) and authorize a 10% contingency for a total not to exceed amount of One Million Five Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,525,150), and to authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby award a contract for Schaffer Canal Restoration Project, without competitive bidding due to no bids having been received to Bid # FY2021-2022-018, to B&Z Construction, LLC for One Million Three Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,386,500,) and authorize a 10% contingency for a total not to exceed amount of One Million Five Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,525,150), and to authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
