RESOLUTION NO. 2025 -

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE UTILIZATION OF THE GSA CONTRACT 47QTCA20D00B5 WITH VERIZON FOR THE PURCHASE OF CELLULAR AND WIRELESS SERVICES AND DEVICES FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$120,000) DOLLARS PER FISCAL YEAR FROM SEPTEMBER 25, 2025, TO SEPTEMBER, 24, 2029, FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$480,000) OVER THE FOUR YEAR TERM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (6), Exception to Bid Requirements, and Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchase, the City Manager is authorized to procure supplies, materials, equipment and services from contracts of other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be served subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires City Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Management Services (DMS) provides contracts available to all government agencies with the best terms and rates for public agencies, and the General Services Administration (GSA) leverages the purchasing power of the Federal Government to offer the best terms and rates for agencies at the Federal/State/Local Level; and

WHEREAS, the use of the negotiated contracts allows state and local governments to use GSA schedules for select purchases under multiple authorized programs, and the utilization of GSA schedules to obtain equipment and services, thereby saving taxpayers money; and

WHEREAS, Verizon Wireless provides essential cellular and wireless internet services that support City operations, including critical communications for the Hallandale Beach Police Department, and is widely utilized by numerous state and

39 local agencies—particularly law enforcement—due to its proven reliability and
40 extensive network coverage; and

42 **WHEREAS**, the Information and Technology (IT) Department manages cellular
43 and wireless internet devices citywide acting as the central department in charge of
44 management the equipment and service. The IT Department also manages the City’s
45 cellular and wireless communications for all City Departments and the current Verizon
46 agreement is expiring; and
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48 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to
49 be in the public interest to authorize the City Manager to issue a Purchase Order to
50 Verizon Wireless to continue to utilize federal General Services Administration (GSA)
51 Contract No. 47QTCA20D00B5 extending the procurement period up to four (4) years
52 from September 25, 2025, to September, 24, 2029 at an estimated cost not to exceed
53 One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) per fiscal year, for a total not to
54 exceed amount of Four Hundred and Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$480,000) over the full
55 four year term, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

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60 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.
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62 **SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization.** The Mayor and City
63 Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a Purchase Order to Verizon
64 Wireless to continue to utilize federal General Services Administration (GSA) Contract
65 No. 47QTCA20D00B5 extending the procurement period up to four (4) years from
66 September 25, 2025, to September, 24, 2029 at an estimated cost not to exceed One
67 Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) per fiscal year, for a total not to exceed
68 amount of Four Hundred and Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$480,000) over the full four
69 year term, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.
