RESOLUTION NO. 2026 -**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF SOURCEWELL CONTRACT #082923-CNH TO PURCHASE A BEACH TRACTOR (REPLACING UNIT 1383) FROM GLADE & GROVE SUPPLY OF SARASOTA LLC IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED, FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED, FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY CENTS (\$152,645.70); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

16           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section  
17 23-9, Award, (e), the City Manager may award procurements within the delegated spending  
18 authority, and all other procurements, except emergency procurements, require commission  
19 approval for award; and

21           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section  
22 23-5 Competitive procurement required; Procurement Mechanisms, Subsection (3)  
23 Cooperative Purchasing, the City may procure goods or services through a variety of  
24 arrangements whereby two or more public entities have the opportunity to purchase from  
25 the same supplier or multiple suppliers using a single competitive procurement mechanism;

28           **WHEREAS**, Sourcewell, a municipal contracting agency, allows government entities  
29 to cooperatively procure equipment and services at discounted rates. By leveraging  
30 Sourcewell's cooperative pricing, the City ensures competitive costs and streamlined  
31 procurement, enabling staff to respond quickly and effectively to emerging needs; and

33           **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach Fleet Department has implemented a  
34 replacement plan that balances the cost of ownership with the operability of fleet assets,  
35 considering factors such as age, utilization, and anticipated surplus value on the  
36 secondary market; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends replacement of beach tractor Unit 1383, which is a 2021 Kubota M6S-111, used to manage sargassum and other debris deposited by ocean tides, because even with washing the tractor after every use, the severe corrosion exposure associated with daily beach operations due to the salt water and air has deteriorated this unit greatly, and the proposed replacement tractor is equipped with additional corrosion resistant parts and larger tires offering better traction in the sand, which will make the replacement more durable and effective; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the public interest to utilize Sourcewell Contract #082923-CNH to purchase a beach tractor (replacing Unit 1383) from Glade & Grove Supply of Sarasota LLC in a not to exceed amount of One Hundred, Fifty-Two Thousand, Six Hundred, Forty-Five Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$152,645.70) and authorize the City Manager to execute all related documents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize utilization of Sourcewell Contract #082923-CNH to purchase a beach tractor (replacing Unit 1383) from Glade & Grove Supply of Sarasota LLC in a not to exceed amount of One Hundred, Fifty-Two Thousand, Six Hundred, Forty-Five Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$152,645.70) and authorize the City Manager to execute all related documents.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
