15 16	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique
17	Circumstances, the City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City Commission")
18	may declare unique circumstances as an exception to the requirements of competitive
19	bidding;
20	
21	WHEREAS, unlike the procurement of most services, insurance products must be
22	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not the
23	city;
24	
25	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") participates in the Florida Municipal
26	Insurance Trust Fund, which is administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited only
27	to municipalities, to insure the City's physical facilities; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, the FMIT fund provides property insurance for all City facilities with a
30	\$25,000 deductible per incident except for windstorm damage, which is five percent (5%) per
31	value of the building deductible; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, the property insurance coverage for all City facilities provided by this trust
34	fund represents the cost to replace damaged property with property of like kind and quality
35	(the "replacement value"); and
36 37	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City renew its current
38	property insurance with Florida Municipal Trust Fund for the total sum of One Million Nine

39	Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred And Twenty-Five Dollars (\$1,914,525) for fisca
40	year 2025-2026; and
41 42 43	WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to renew the City's current property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund.

55	hereby approve the renewal of the City's property insurance through the Florida Municipa
56	Insurance Trust Fund in the amount of One Million Nine Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five
57	Hundred And Twenty-Five Dollars (\$1,914,525) Dollars and hereby authorize the City
58	Manager to execute all related documents to effectuate the renewal of the City's property
59	insurance.
