A RESOLUTION OF THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AWARDING RFP # FY 2023-2024 CRA03 DISPOSAL OF REAL PROPERTY IN A COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA DEVELOPMENT OF A MIXED USED DEVELOPMENT IN HARLEM VILLAGE TO DRAGONFLY INVESTMENTS, LLC; **AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND HBCRA** ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE AND **FINALIZE** REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT WITH DRAGONFLY INVESTMENTS, LLC TO BE BROUGHT BACK TO THE HBCRA BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2024, the City of Hallandale Beach (the "City") Procurement Department issued a Request for Proposals, RFP # FY 2023-2024 CRA03 Disposal of Real Property in a Community Redevelopment Area and Development of a Mixed Used Development in Harlem Village (the "RFP"), on behalf of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (the "HBCRA"); and

WHEREAS, the RFP sought to identify proposers with qualifications to develop, design, construct, finance, operate and maintain a mixed-use development with related improvements, including a mix of uses including retail, grocery, office, restaurant, residential, and commercial uses on a thirty nine thousand (39,000) square-foot parcel of real property owned by the HBCRA located adjacent to Fire Station 7, within the newly named Harlem Village area; and

WHEREAS, the RFP was sent to over one thousand nine hundred (1900) vendors, including vendors from the City's vendor list and pertinent vendors that have a City Business Tax License to operate in the City; and

WHEREAS, the RFP was also advertised on the Hallandale Beach Chamber of Commerce website, the City's website, DEMANDSTAR.com, City Social Media pages, Miami Minority Business Development Agency Business Center, U.S. Small Business Administration, Broward County Community Relations and Outreach Section Office of Economic and Small Business Development; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk's office received a total of four (4) proposals in response to the RFP and all four (4) proposals were evaluated by the HBCRA Evaluation Committee; and

WHEREAS, the HBCRA Evaluation Committee, upon review of the proposals, determined that one of the proposers did not meet MQR #1 and was disqualified; with the following three firms meeting the MQR's: B2J Development Group, Integral Florida, and Dragonfly Investments, LLC; and

WHEREAS, based on the RFP process, and the Evaluation Committee's review and 47 scoring, HBCRA staff recommends that the RFP be awarded to Dragonfly Investments, LLC, and 48 49 that the Executive Director and the HBCRA Attorney will negotiate and finalize a Redevelopment Agreement with Dragonfly Investments, LLC, to be brought back to the HBCRA Board of Directors 50 for review and approval. 51 52 53 WHEREAS, the HBCRA Board of Directors desires to (a) award the RFP to Dragonfly Investments, LLC, and (b) authorize the Executive Director and the HBCRA Attorney to negotiate 54 and finalize a Redevelopment Agreement with Dragonfly Investments, LLC, to be brought back 55 to the HBCRA Board of Directors for review and approval. 56 57 58 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS 59 OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY: 60 61 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and incorporated into this Resolution. 62 63 64 Section 2. Award of the RFP. The award of the RFP to Dragonfly Investments, LLC is 65 hereby approved. 66 Section 3. Negotiation and Finalization of Redevelopment Agreement. The Executive 67 Director and HBCRA Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize a Redevelopment 68 69 Agreement with Dragonfly Investments, LLC, to be brought back to the HBCRA Board of Directors for review and approval. 70 71 72 Section 4. Effective Date.
