Good afternoon Dr. Earle,

I am writing to inform you of an urgent electrical emergency that resulted from the recent watermain break during repair activities. Although our Distribution Supervisor called in for utility locates, the electrical line that was struck was not shown on any of our utility maps. The line was damaged and as a result the wiring and panel burned out. This

incident posed a serious safety risk because our crew could have been severely injured. Our City Electrician was able to disconnect the wiring, but the scope of this work is too large for him to complete. I am requesting your approval to move forward with engaging our electrical contractor to perform the necessary repairs and to contact FPL to reconnect the wiring to the pole.

Currently, the Golden Isles area does not have surveillance camera coverage due to this electrical outage which leaves the community exposed. For both safety and security reasons, I am requesting approval to proceed with the repair as soon as possible.

Please advise at your earliest convenience.

Good afternoon Team,

Please be advised that water service has been fully restored. The Water Plant will be coming out to take water samples for bacteriological testing to ensure compliance and safety.

The 8" watermain involved in the incident has been capped and abandoned in place. Boil water notices were hand delivered to each home affected.

As an FYI, during the repair efforts, some electrical lines feeding the Police Department cameras were damaged while exposing the watermain. These lines were not marked or located, and it was unknown that power was in the vicinity of digging. As a result, we will need to notify FPL to replace the meter, meter can, and associated wiring.

We will be contacting FPL first thing in the morning for further investigation and repair.

Good morning team,

This email is to report a break on the 8-inch watermain located at the east end of Holiday Drive and Layne Boulevard. This line is an older main that should have been abandoned previously, and we are now preparing a plan to permanently abandon it to prevent future issues.

During the incident, we experienced a loss of slightly over 10 MGD. Valves in the area were isolated promptly, and our system has since been restored to normal working pressure.

As a precautionary measure, a boil water advisory will be issued for Holiday Drive only. Once the system is confirmed back online, the plant will be notified, and door hangers will be distributed to all affected residences.
