RESOLUTION NO. 2026 -**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT WITH 72 HOUR LLC D/B/A NATIONAL AUTO FLEET GROUP TO PURCHASE FOURTEEN (14) VEHICLES FROM AUTHORIZED DEALER ALAN JAY AUTOMOTIVE MANAGEMENT INC. FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED, FORTY THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN DOLLARS (\$640,716) AND DISPOSE OF THE REPLACED VEHICLES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY'S SURPLUS PROPERTY POLICIES AND APPLICABLE LAWS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,  
22 Section 23-9, Award, (e), the City Manager may award procurements within the  
23 delegated spending authority, and all other procurements, except emergency  
24 procurements, require commission approval for award; and

25  
26           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,  
27 Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; procurement mechanisms,  
28 Subsection (3) Cooperative purchasing, the City may procure goods or services  
29 through a variety of arrangements whereby two or more public entities have the  
30 opportunity to purchase from the same supplier or multiple suppliers using a single  
31 competitive procurement mechanism; and

33           **WHEREAS**, Sourcewell, a municipal contracting agency, allows government  
34 entities to cooperatively procure equipment and services at discounted rates. By  
35 leveraging Sourcewell's cooperative pricing, the City ensures competitive costs and  
36 streamlined procurement, enabling staff to respond quickly and effectively to emerging  
37 needs; and

39           **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach Fleet Department implemented a  
40 strategic replacement plan designed to balance total cost of ownership with the  
41 operational reliability of fleet assets, evaluating key factors including vehicle age,  
42 utilization rates, maintenance history, and anticipated surplus value in the secondary  
43 market; and

44

45           **WHEREAS**, Staff has identified needed replacement of fourteen (14) vehicles  
46 for a not to exceed amount of Six Hundred, Forty Thousand, Seven Hundred and  
47 Sixteen Dollars (\$640,716) and disposal of the replaced vehicles in accordance with  
48 the City’s surplus property policies and applicable laws; and

50           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to  
51 be in the public interest to authorize utilization of Sourcewell Contract No. 091521-  
52 NAF Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with 72 Hour LLC d/b/a National Auto Fleet  
53 Group (Cars, trucks, vans, SUVs, cab chassis, and other vehicles) to purchase  
54 fourteen (14) vehicles from authorized dealer Alan Jay Automotive Management Inc.  
55 for a not to exceed amount of Six Hundred, Forty Thousand, Seven Hundred and  
56 Sixteen Dollars (\$640,716) and dispose of the replaced vehicles in accordance with  
57 the City’s surplus property policies and applicable laws, and authorize the City  
58 Manager to execute relating documents.

60           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
61 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

63           **SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

65           **SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization.**       The Mayor and City  
66 Commission hereby authorize utilization of Sourcewell Contract No. 091521-NAF  
67 Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with 72 Hour LLC d/b/a National Auto Fleet Group  
68 (Cars, trucks, vans, SUVs, cab chassis, and other vehicles) to purchase fourteen (14)  
69 vehicles from authorized dealer Alan Jay Automotive Management Inc. for a not to  
70 exceed amount of Six Hundred, Forty Thousand, Seven Hundred and Sixteen Dollars  
71 (\$640,716) and dispose of the replaced vehicles in accordance with the City’s surplus

72 property policies and applicable laws, and authorize the City Manager to execute  
73 relating documents.

75 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect  
76 immediately upon its passage and adoption.
