20	WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (HBCRA) is
21	dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for its residents; and
22	WHEREAS, the HBCRA intends to partner with Pinnacle at Audubon Place, LLLP (the
23	"Developer") in the development of a mixed-use development known as "Pinnacle at Audubon
24	Place" (the "Project"), located at 219 West Pembroke Road within the City of Hallandale
25	Beach ("City"); and
26	WHEREAS, the project will consist of 116 multifamily units designated for seniors
27	aged sixty-two (62) and older with incomes at or below sixty percent (60%) of the area median
28	income (AMI) for a minimum of fifty (50) years; and
20	indefine (, twii) for a fill third of filty (66) years, and
29	WHEREAS, the Developer aims to secure Low Income Housing Tax Credits through
30	the Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC); and
31	WHEREAS, the HBCRA has requested that the City partner with HBCRA and the
32	Developer on the Project, with the HBCRA, through the City, providing a forgivable loan to
33	Developer in an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars
34	(\$640,000.00), contingent upon Developer securing an award of Low Income Housing Tax
J- T	(45 15,555.55), contingent apon borolops, socially an award of Low months flowing rax

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Credits through FHFC; and

WHEREAS, the loan will constitute the City's local support under Florida Housing's "Local Government Area of Opportunity" guidelines, and will be the only such designated development by the City for the next two (2) years of Florida Housing application cycles for 9% Low Income Housing Tax Credits; and

WHEREAS, the HBCRA will administer the loan on behalf of the City and coordinate closely on all aspects of the Project's funding; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission consider and approve the proposed loan by the City to Developer for the proposed project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby adopted herein.

SECTION 2. Approval of Contingent Loan. The Mayor and City Commission hereby approve a loan in the amount of Six Hundred Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$640,000.00), to Pinnacle at Audubon Place, LLLP, or its affiliates, for the Project, subject to an award of Low Income Housing Tax Credits from the Florida Housing Finance Corporation to Developer for the project within two (2) competitive cycles, commencing from the effective date of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. Authority of City Manager. Except for the authority to increase the amount of the loan or to waive the affordable housing commitment, the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate additional terms and conditions, modify the terms, take further actions, and make such further determinations he deems advisable to effectuate the intent this Resolution. The City Manager is further authorized to execute any and all documents or loan instruments necessary or incidental to effectuating the loan transaction authorized by this Resolution, including, but not limited to, the proposed loan Commitment Letter of Interest (LOI), Florida Housing Finance Corporation Local Government Area of Opportunity Funding Form, Subordination Agreements or Intercreditor Agreements.
