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RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - 031

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A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, FINDING UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL MULTISENSOR PUBLIC SAFETY CAMERAS AND LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION CAMERAS FOR A TOTAL COST OF ONE MILLION, TWO HUNDRED, NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$1,295,443) AS PART OF PHASE 1 OF THE CITYWIDE PUBLIC SAFETY PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (5), *Unique Circumstances*, of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances provides an exception to the competitive bidding requirement where the City Commission finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City; however, such purchases in excess of \$50,000.00 shall require a formal, written contract approved by the City Commission; and

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WHEREAS, on March 19, 2023, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-032, citing unique circumstances to utilize the discount pricing from the Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for converting and maintaining the citywide CCTV system to Motorola's Avigilon platform; and

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WHEREAS, on September 25, 2024, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2024-086, citing unique circumstances to utilize the discount pricing from the Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for installing twelve (12) Avigilon CCTV cameras from Motorola Solutions, Inc., in line with Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) standards, which mandate video surveillance for parked police vehicles, in an amount not to exceed Thirty Two Thousand Four Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$32,415), including a five-year warranty on all parts and one year of labor; and

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WHEREAS, Staff seek approval to expand the Citywide Public Safety Program by purchasing an additional fourteen (14) multisensor public safety cameras (each containing

four cameras) and forty-eight (48) License Plate Recognition (LPR) cameras, which purchase will also include a five-year warranty covering parts and a one-year warranty for labor, provided by Motorola Solutions, such cameras being fully compatible with the existing system, which is integrated with the Broward County Real Time Crime Center (RTCC); and

WHEREAS, by way of separate resolutions, staff will seek approval of cameras for two additional areas of concern, the EV Bus Chargin Lot and the Water Treatment facility, not included in the authorization herein; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for Phase 1 of the Citywide Public Safety Program is One Million, Two Hundred, Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty Three Dollars (\$1,295,443), excluding the EV Bus Charging Lot and Water Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public interest to approve unique circumstances to authorize the proposal utilizing the discount pricing of Broward Sheriff s Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS, in order to purchase and install an additional fourteen (14) multisensor public safety cameras (each containing four cameras) and forty-eight (48) License Plate Recognition (LPR) cameras for a cost for Phase 1 of the Citywide Public Safety Program of One Million, Two Hundred, Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty Three Dollars (\$1,295,443), excluding the EV Bus Parking Lot and Water Treatment Facility, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

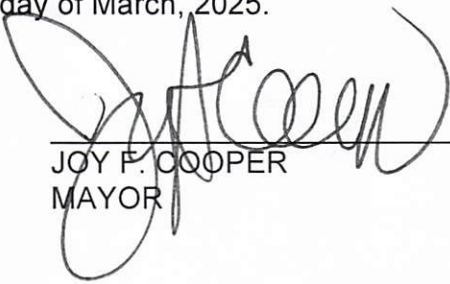
SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

The Mayor and City Commission hereby find it in the public interest to approve unique circumstances to authorize the proposal utilizing the discount pricing of Broward Sheriff s Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS, in order to purchase and install an additional fourteen (14) multisensor public safety cameras (each containing four cameras) and forty-eight (48) License Plate Recognition (LPR) cameras for a new total cost for Phase

1 of the Citywide Public Safety Program of One Million, Two Hundred, Ninety-Five Thousand,
Four Hundred and Forty Three Dollars (\$1,295,443), excluding the EV Bus Charging Lot and
Water Treatment Facility, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
passage and adoption.

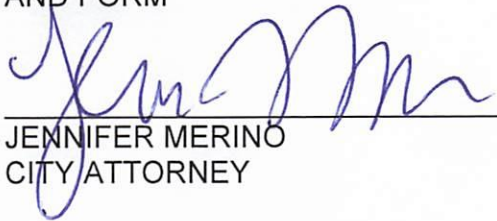
