**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE
BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARING RFP 25-26-08
CITYWIDE BIKE-SHARE PROGRAM
IMPLEMENTATION, OPERATIONS, AND
MAINTENANCE SERVICE TO VENDOR DROPBIKE,
CORP. TO PROVIDE A CITY BIKE-SHARE SYSTEM
FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$70,000) ANNUALLY; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

16 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,
17 Section 23-5, Competitive procurement required, Procurement Mechanisms. (a), all
18 purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services in excess
19 of the delegated spending authority, shall be based on a competitive procurement
20 process and Section 23-9 Award, (e) while the City Manager may award procurements
21 within delegated spending authority, all other procurements, except emergency
22 procurements, require commission approval for award; and
23

24 **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach seeks to implement a citywide bike-
25 share program to expand local mobility options for residents and visitors and support
26 the City's multimodal transportation goals; and
27

28 **WHEREAS**, the bike-share program will advance the City's transportation and
29 mobility objectives because it supports short local trips, improves first-mile and last-
30 mile connectivity, and expands multimodal transportation options for residents and
31 visitors utilizing a fully integrated system that includes bicycles, stations, mobile
32 technology, operations, maintenance, and customer support; and

34 **WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2026, the City released RFP 25-26-08 Citywide
35 Bike-Share Program Implementation, Operations, and Maintenance Service for a fully
36 integrated bike-share system under which the selected vendor will assume
37 responsibility for program implementation, operations, and maintenance of at least five

38 stations and approximately five bicycles per station, for a minimum of 25 bicycles, with
39 the ability to expand as demand increases; and

41 **WHEREAS**, vendor Dropbike, Corp. was selected as the highest ranked,
42 responsive, and responsible proposer for the bike-share program for an amount not
43 to exceed \$70,000.00 per year, with an initial term of one year and up to five optional
44 renewal years; and

46 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission authorize
47 award of RFP 25-26-08 Citywide Bike-Share Program Implementation, Operations,
48 and Maintenance Service to vendor Dropbike, Corp. to provide a fully integrated City
49 bike-share system including program implementation, operations, and maintenance of
50 at least five stations and 25 bicycles for a not to exceed amount of Seventy Thousand
51 Dollars (\$70,000) each year, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating
52 documents.

54 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
55 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

57 **SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are
58 incorporated herein.

60 **SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission
61 hereby authorize award of RFP 25-26-08 Citywide Bike-Share Program
62 Implementation, Operations, and Maintenance Service to vendor Dropbike, Corp. to
63 provide a fully integrated City bike-share system including program implementation,
64 operations, and maintenance of at least five stations and 25 bicycles for a not to
65 exceed amount of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) each year, with an initial
66 term of one year and up to five optional renewal years and authorize the City
67 Manager to execute relating documents.

69 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect
70 immediately upon its passage and adoption.
