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26 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all
27 purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated
28 cost shall exceed \$50,000.00 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to
29 Chapter 23, Section 23-6 Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to
30 recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and
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32 **WHEREAS**, the City obtained a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan to address the major
33 issue of infiltration and inflow intrusion of water and sand into the sanitary system. The funds
34 may only be used to secure the services of a consultant to study and analyze our current sanitary
35 infrastructure, provide recommendations, and develop specifications and bid document for the
36 construction phase; and
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38 **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach has performed studies and rehabilitation work
39 over many years, in an effort to reduce Infiltration and Inflow (I&I) throughout its wastewater
40 collection system; and
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42 **WHEREAS**, the ITB notice was sent to four hundred and forty-one (441) vendors from
43 the City's vendor list, and was advertised in the Hallandale Beach Chamber of Commerce
44 website, City website, DemandStar Website, the Miami Minority Business Development Agency

45 Business Center, the U.S. Small Business Administration, and the Broward County Community
46 Relations and Outreach Section Office of Economic and Small Business Development; and
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48 **WHEREAS**, a mandatory pre-bid conference was held on February 28, 2019 and the Bid
49 allowed for additional questions to be sent vial email by no later than March 5, 2019; and
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51 **WHEREAS**, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award
52 BID#2018-2019-003, City of Hallandale Beach Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase 2 Main Line
53 Repairs, to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder American Infrastructure Technologies,
54 Corporation for an amount not to exceed one million five hundred seventy-seven thousand one
55 hundred (\$1,577,100) dollars plus and ten (10%) percent contingency for the rehabilitation of the
56 sewer pipe line system to control inflow and infiltration; and
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58 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
59 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.
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61 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF**
62 **THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**
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64 **SECTION 1. City Commission Action.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby award
65 FY #2018-2019-003, City of Hallandale Beach Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase 2 Main Line
66 Repairs, to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder American Infrastructure Technologies,
67 Corporation for an amount not to exceed one million seven hundred thirty-four thousand eight
68 hundred ten (\$1,734,810) dollars, which includes a ten (10%) percent contingency for the
69 rehabilitation of the sewer pipe line system to control inflow and infiltration.
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71 **SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby
72 authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with American Infrastructure
73 Technologies Corporation for an amount not to exceed one million seven hundred thirty-four
74 thousand eight hundred ten (\$1,734,810) dollars, which includes a ten (10%) percent contingency
75 for the rehabilitation of the sewer pipe line system to control inflow and infiltration. The City
76 Manager is authorized to negotiate with the second ranked firm should negotiations not be
77 successful. The City Manager is further authorized to execute all related documents to effectuate
78 this project.
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81 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
82 adoption.


