13	WHEREAS, The City and School Board have existing agreements for the use of
14	specific facilities, but no agreements that address the City's use of other SBBC facilities nor
15 16	allow an SBBC school to use other City facilities; and
17	WHEREAS, in May, 2023, due to indemnification requirements, the SBBC General
18	Counsel opined that SBBC schools may not enter into the City's use agreements to utilize
19	City facilities without either prior written permission from the School Board for each use or a
20	current RUA between the parties. This does not affect the City's use of SBBC facilities but,
21	due to the time-consuming process on their end to obtain Board approval, has prohibited
22	the schools from using the City facilities they rely on for their athletic and enrichment needs;
23	and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the proposed Reciprocal Use Agreement provides a mechanism for the
26	City and the SBBC to use each other's facilities at no rental cost when the facilities are
27	available. The RUA is a supplemental agreement and does not supersede any other
28	agreement between the parties which relates to the use of specific facilities; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the
31	public interest to enter into a Reciprocal Use Agreement between the City of Hallandale
32	Beach and the School Board of Broward County which will allow the SBBC and the City to
33	utilize each other's facilities, and authorize the City Manager to execute any relating
34	documents.
