After reviewing the city commission agenda, as well as Golden Isles Safe Neighborhood District agenda, I'm good to go, but have a concern about Golden Isles Safe Neighborhood District.

My question and suggestion will impact the item, and I will not be in attendance at this meeting.

After discussing with the city attorney, she said such suggestion could be put in writing and read into record.

Sending this to be shared in hopes that it can be addressed and included in the item.

A few years back when we initiated installing cameras we had requested to see if we could put them on the end islands where there is direct access to our homes.

At that time it wasn't certain what kind of approvals we needed from property owners, or if in fact, there were cameras that could be placed there. There were concerns over easements and the type of cameras due to salt water exposure. The project was not never not completed.

Fast forward. I am happy that we are moving in the direction of completing and upgrading all our camera systems.

However, I would like to see if we can add cameras on the east point of Holiday Drive as well as the north and south of Palm .

The center property line at end of Holiday would be ideal and the same for south Palm. Since the north corner of Palm is being developed maybe ideal time to work with owner . These locations would also work for Golden Isles Lake where properties are also vulnerable. In addition maybe help with intracoastal.

This would allow for monitoring these points of access to the canal systems .

With the recent boat break ins as well as increase in thefts I believe this would be prudent measure to research and add if feasible .

As I will not be in attendance I am hoping my colleagues will add an amendment to research and approve expansion if feasible .
