**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT PRICE FOR SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD SERVICES WITH WATERFIELD FLORIDA STAFFING, LLC DBA ACTION LABOR, DBA STAFFING CONNECTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY ONE DOLLARS (\$13,881), FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT THREE HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY THREE DOLLARS (\$368,443); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on October 14, 2020, the Hallandale Beach City Commission (“City Commission”) adopted Resolution No. 2020-089, awarding a 5-year contract to Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection (“Vendor”) for school crossing guard services in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Five Thousand Five Hundred Ten Dollars (\$305,510), and since the adoption of the current contract, “Florida Amendment 2 of 2020—Raising Florida’s Minimum Wage” has passed, impacting the Vendor's labor costs; and

**WHEREAS**, in response to this amendment, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-011 on February 15, 2023, approving a change order to the school crossing guard contract and increasing the total contract amount to Three Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars (\$354,562); and

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends increasing the annual contract amount by Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$13,881) in FY 2024-25 to reflect Florida’s latest minimum wage increase, bringing the total contract amount to Three Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Four Hundred Forty Three Dollars (\$368,443), which ensures reliable crossing guard services and remains more competitive than hiring uninformed officers; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Section 23-12 Procedures for purchases in excess of \$50,000, item (7)(a) Change Orders, any change in the contract

38 price, scope of work or time of for completion of any project following the award of a contract  
39 shall be by a written change order, the scope of any project may not be changed without prior  
40 approval of the City Commission, and no change order shall materially change the scope of  
41 work unless approved by the City Commission; and

43 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission find that it is in the best interest of the  
44 residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to approve a change order to the contract price for  
45 school crossing guard services with the Vendor in an amount not to exceed Thirteen  
46 Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$13,881) in FY 2024-25, increasing the total  
47 contract amount to Three Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Four Hundred Forty Three Dollars  
48 (\$368,443), and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

50 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
51 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

53 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

54  
55 **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby approve a change order to the  
56 contract price for school crossing guard services with the Vendor in an amount not to exceed  
57 Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$13,881) in FY 2024-25, increasing  
58 the total contract amount to Three Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Four Hundred Forty Three  
59 Dollars (\$368,443), and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

61 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its  
62 passage and adoption.
