Good ~~afternoon~~^{evening}, Mayor and Commissioners. My name is Dalia Rodriguez.

I am here today regarding ~~main reason~~ ongoing concerns with operations at the City Cemetery.

I want to address the statement that the State found no violations. After reviewing that response, it is clear the State's review was limited and did not address operational issues such as access, staff conduct, or safety incidents.

Those concerns remain.

On February 11, I was locked inside the cemetery and had to call emergency services. Since then, there have been ongoing issues with inconsistent enforcement of visiting hours and how concerns from residents are being handled.

I have also had to submit multiple supplemental statements to correct inaccuracies in incident reports, including statements that are factually incorrect and not based on observed conduct.

This is concerning because it creates a record that does not reflect what actually occurred and shifts attention away from the real issues.

While I am speaking about the cemetery, I also want to note that similar concerns regarding communication and transparency extend to other areas, including parks and CRA-related matters.

Across these issues, the pattern is the same: lack of clear policies, inconsistent enforcement, and limited transparency.

I am submitting this supplemental statement to address serious inaccuracies and concerning statements contained in this report.

1. False Statement – “Waiting in a Car”

The report states that I was waiting in my car.

This is factually incorrect.

I do not have a vehicle and was not in a car at any time. This statement is false and should be corrected.

2. Allegations of Harassment and Threats

The report includes claims that I have been harassing staff and making threats, both physical and verbal.

These allegations are unsubstantiated and do not reflect my conduct.

I have not made any physical threats, nor have I engaged in behavior that would constitute harassment. My interactions have been limited to raising concerns regarding cemetery access, conditions, and operations.

3. Claim of “Hiding”

The report suggests that I was hiding.

This is inaccurate.

The cemetery grounds and surrounding areas are open and visible. There is no basis for this claim. My presence has been open and observable.

4. Subjective Statements Presented as Fact

The report appears to include subjective interpretations and assumptions about my intent rather than documented actions.

Statements regarding anticipated behavior or perceived intent are not based on observable conduct and should not be presented as factual findings.

5. Timing and Pattern of Report

This report was created after I began raising concerns publicly and attending meetings.

I was not aware of this report at the time it was created and only became aware of it later.

This raises concern regarding the timing and basis for its creation.

6. Request for Review

I respectfully request:

- Review of the accuracy of statements contained in this report
 - Clarification of the source of the allegations
 - Correction of any false or unsupported claims
 - Inclusion of this supplemental statement in the official record

I am submitting this supplemental statement to address inaccuracies and missing context in the above-referenced report.

1. Incorrect Timeline and Context

The report indicates officer presence at approximately 2:30 PM on February 11, 2026. This timing and context require clarification.

On this actually happen on 2-12-26, my family members were meeting with cemetery staff inside the office regarding burial plots. I remained outside and did not engage with cemetery staff during that interaction.

2. No Interaction with Staff

I did not approach, speak to, or confront cemetery staff during this time. Any implication that I was involved in a disturbance or interaction with staff is inaccurate.

3. Purpose of Presence

I was present in connection with my family's visit regarding cemetery arrangements. I provide my id so it can be sent with my family details for purchase. My presence was not for any disruptive purpose.

4. Officer Presence Without Clear Cause

An officer later arrived with a Public Works employee but did not engage with me or my family at the time.

When I later contacted the police department for clarification, I was advised that there was no active call for service and that the officer was in the area routinely.

This raises concern as to why a report was later generated if no incident or call for service was identified at that time.

5. Recording Clarification

I was recording during this timeframe. The recording reflects the physical layout of the cemetery office area, including a clear and unobstructed view of the grounds. This contradicts any implication that I was concealing myself or acting in a suspicious manner.

6. Request for Clarification

I respectfully request clarification regarding:

- The basis for generating this report**
- The source of information used to create the narrative**
- Whether any direct observation of my conduct was documented**

7. Purpose

This statement is submitted to ensure the record accurately reflects that I did not engage in any interaction or conduct that would justify the creation of this report.

I am submitting this supplemental statement to address inaccuracies and provide clarification regarding the events described in this report dated February 12, 2026.

1. Purpose of Visit

On February 12, 2026, I was present at the cemetery during posted visiting hours for the purpose of visiting my family at 5:30pm

At no time was I present to cause a disturbance or create a problem.

2. Interaction with Staff

A cemetery worker with long dreadlocks approached me and advised that it was time to leave. At 5:47pm

I respectfully responded that, based on the posted hours, I still had approximately 20 minutes remaining before closing.

The employee then stated that if I did not leave, police would be called again and big issue like yesterday.

3. Voluntary Compliance

I left the cemetery on my own without any escalation.

There was:

- No disturbance
- No argument requiring intervention
- No need for law enforcement involvement

4. Lack of Awareness of Report

I was not aware that a report had been created regarding this interaction until a later date.

This is concerning, as the interaction was brief, non-confrontational, and resolved voluntarily. Police report states at 5:39pm but I did not leave until after 5:47pm after interaction and the gates started to lock.

5. Documentation

I have a recording of this interaction which reflects that:

- My tone remained calm
- I complied and left the property
- There was no behavior that would justify escalation

6. Request for Clarification

I respectfully request clarification as to:

- Why a report was generated for a non-escalated interaction
- Whether the report reflects direct observation or solely staff statements

7. Purpose

This statement is submitted to ensure that the record reflects that I complied voluntarily and did not engage in any conduct warranting a negative or escalated report.
