**SHORT TITLE:**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF THE RESILIENT BROWARD GRANT AGREEMENT THROUGH BROWARD COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) TO FUND PART OF THE CONSTRUCTION COSTS OF THE GULFSTREAM STORMWATER PIPE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**STAFF SUMMARY:**

**Summary:**

Staff is seeking City Commission approval and acceptance of the Resilient Broward Grant Agreement through Broward County in the amount of \$250,000. This amount will be utilized for the construction costs of the Gulfstream Park Stormwater Pipe Improvement project (P2305). The total estimate for the construction of this project is approximately \$3.7 million.

## **Background:**

Broward County announced the Resilient Broward Culvert Grant Program, which is a competitive grant program that aims to provide funds for flood reduction initiatives in Broward County. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners allocated \$1.5 million in FY 2026 to provide cost-share funds for eligible projects.

As this grant opportunity did not fall within the submission window for inclusion in the City's Annual Grants Matrix, the City's Grants Division, in partnership with the Department of Public Works, pursued this grant application for the Gulfstream rehabilitation project. The proposed project includes the rehabilitation and replacement of approximately 2,500 linear feet of an existing 72-inch stormwater pipe in poor condition located at the southern end of Gulfstream Park.

The existing stormwater infrastructure is a vital drainage conveyance for the surrounding community, providing drainage for properties west of US-1 to east of Dixie Highway and for the southwest Gulfstream community in general. The rehabilitation of this pipe will improve the conveyance of stormwater and alleviate localized flooding in the surrounding community, which includes the adjacent commercial properties and residential neighborhoods.

## **Current Situation:**

The Broward County Board of County Commissioners has approved the FY 2026 Resilient Broward Culvert Grant Awards, and we are now in the process of moving forward with the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) phase. The City of Hallandale was awarded \$250,000 in grant funds for this project.

The ILA from Broward County has been received by the City, which must be approved by the City Commission before execution by the City Manager. Once executed by both parties, it will enable us to move forward with this project in accordance with the requirements of the grant funds. Design for the Gulfstream 72-inch storm pipe rehabilitation project is 90% complete.

## **Why Action is Necessary:**

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01, of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, Resolutions are to be presented to and adopted by a majority of the Commission. Furthermore, as per the Grants Administrative Policy, a resolution of the City Commission authorizing the approval and acceptance of the grant application and/or award is required.

## **Cost Benefit:**

Acceptance of the award of \$250,000 from the Resilient Broward Culvert Grant will provide financial assistance toward the rehabilitation of the Gulfstream 72-inch stormwater pipe, reducing the City's overall cost for the project while supporting improvements to critical stormwater infrastructure and flood mitigation in the surrounding area.
