A RESOLUTION OF THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE **HALLANDALE** BEACH **COMMUNITY** REDEVELOPMENT **HALLANDALE** AGENCY. BEACH. FLORIDA; APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH AND THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY AGENCY RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF DIRECT SERVICES CONSISTING OF THE FUNDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL FULL-TIME CODE COMPLIANCE SPECIALIST TO THE CITY FROM THE HBCRA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$97,320.00; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT: AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (the "HBCRA") desires that the City of Hallandale Beach (the "City") provide certain direct services generally consisting of the provision of funding by the HBCRA to the City for an additional full-time Code Compliance Specialist for Fiscal Year 2024-2025; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 163.400, Florida Statutes, known as Cooperation by Public Bodies, encourages municipalities to do any and all things necessary to aid or cooperate in the planning or carrying out of a community redevelopment plan and related redevelopment activities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to approve the Interlocal Agreement relating to the provision of direct services consisting of the provision of funding by the HBCRA to the City for an additional full-time Code Compliance Specialist for Fiscal Year 2024-2025, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof in an amount not to exceed Ninety Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty and 00/100 (\$97,320.00), which includes funding for the cost for a full-time Code Compliance Specialist salary and benefits, uniforms, shoes, specialized materials and equipment, automobiles, motor vehicle gas, parts and supplies, licenses/certifications and trainings/seminars, and other operating costs.
