3 RESOLUTION NO. 2024 -  
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5 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION  
6 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,  
7 AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR INFLOW AND  
8 INFILTRATION PHASE 2A LATERAL TELEVISIONING AND  
9 LINING PROJECT TO BLD SERVICES, LLC IN THE  
10 AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION, ONE HUNDRED AND FIVE  
11 THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY DOLLARS  
12 (\$2,105,580); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, City of Hallandale Beach Code of  
15 Ordinances, purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services,  
16 when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000, except as specifically provided in that section,  
17 shall be based, wherever possible, on competitive bids; and  
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19 WHEREAS, pursuant to Code of Ordinances, in accordance with Procurement Code  
20 Section 23-8 "Exception to bid requirements, (4) *No bid received*, Where no bid has been  
21 received after publication of a bid proposal, such purchases in excess of \$50,000 may be  
22 approved by the City Commission if they approve a formal, written contract; and  
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24 WHEREAS, the City's proposed Phase 2A Lateral televising and lining project is a  
25 continuation of the efforts to address and remediate inflow and infiltration within the sanitary  
26 sewer system to identify and address areas where groundwater or stormwater is infiltrating  
27 the sewer system, crucial for maintaining the integrity and efficiency of the City's wastewater  
28 infrastructure; and  
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30 WHEREAS, on September 19, 2023, the City published Bid No. FY 2022-2023-020  
31 for the Inflow and Infiltration Phase 2 Lateral Televising and Lining Project to repair  
32 approximately 385 lateral connections, conduct video inspections, and clean approximately  
33 3,500 linear feet of sewer mains and about 650 linear feet of lateral lines, as well as to repair  
34 and install lateral cleanouts to help the City and residents inspect and maintain the  
35 wastewater lines serving individual properties; and  
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37           **WHEREAS**, no proposals were submitted by the bid closing date of October 23, 2023,  
38 and pursuant to Florida Statute 255.20 and the City’s Procurement Code, Section 23-8 (4)  
39 No Bid Received, the City may proceed with soliciting quotes; and

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41           **WHEREAS**, after evaluating the situation and considering options, City staff decided  
42 the best course of action was to obtain quotes directly from vendors experienced in this type  
43 of work in Broward County, who has successfully completed similar projects within the City,  
44 and BLD Services, LLC provided the lowest responsible quote for the inflow and infiltration  
45 Phase 2A Lateral televising and lining project that the City solicited through Bid No. FY 2022-  
46 2023-020; and

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48           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public  
49 interest to authorize an agreement for inflow and infiltration Phase 2A Lateral televising and  
50 lining project to BLD Services, LLC in an amount of Two Million, One Hundred and Five  
51 Thousand, Five Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$2,105,580). The City Commission further  
52 authorizes a seven percent (7%) contingency for a not to exceed amount of Two Million, Two  
53 Hundred, Fifty-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Seventy-One Dollars (\$2,252,971), and  
54 authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

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56           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
57 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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59           **SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

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61           **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby award the contract outlined in  
62 Bid No. FY 2022-2023-020 for inflow and infiltration Phase 2A Lateral televising and lining  
63 project to the company that proposed the lowest responsible quote after a no bid solicitation  
64 to BLD Services, LLC in the amount of Two Million, One Hundred and Five Thousand, Five  
65 Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$2,105,580). The City Commission further authorizes a seven  
66 percent (7%) contingency for a not to exceed amount of Two Million, Two Hundred, Fifty-Two  
67 Thousand, Nine Hundred and Seventy-One Dollars (\$2,252,971), and authorize the City  
68 Manager to execute relating documents.

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**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
