16	estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore,
17	pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the
18	authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and
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20 21	WHEREAS, Hallandale Beach is home to many students who rely on walking as
22	their primary method of commuting to and from school. As a result, children often must
23	traverse busy Hallandale Beach Boulevard and Pembroke Road on their way to and from
24	school; and
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26	WHEREAS, providing crossing guard services is an essential and necessary
27	service to help ensure the safety of school children; and
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29	WHEREAS, July 8, 2020, the City released Re-Bid # FY 2019-2020-006, School
30	Crossing Guard Services to provide school crossing guard services for the school children
31	of the City Hallandale Beach; and
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33	WHEREAS, the City sought responses from qualified and experienced firms and
34	on July 16,2020, the City held a non-mandatory pre-bid conference in which there were
35	no vendor participation; and
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37	WHEREAS, on August 5, 2020, the City received one (1) response from Waterfield

Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection; and

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WHEREAS, City Staff has determined that Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection is the lowest responsible and responsive bid at sixty-one thousand one hundred and two dollars (\$61,102.00) for the first year and a total potential contract cost of three hundred five thousand five hundred and ten (\$305,510) dollars if the City exercises four optional renewals; and

 WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award Re-Bid # FY 2019-2020-006, School Crossing Guard Services, to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection, and to authorize the City Manager to negotiate an agreement to effectuate the service; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are adopted herein.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> <u>City Commission Action.</u> The Mayor and City Commission hereby award Re-Bid # FY 2019-2020-006, School Crossing Guard Services, to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection.

 SECTION 3. City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection in an amount not to exceed sixty-one thousand one hundred and two dollars (\$61,102.00) for the first year and a total potential contract cost of three hundred five thousand five hundred and ten (\$305,510) dollars if the City exercises four optional renewals, to be exercised at the City Manager's discretion. The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute all
