A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARDED RE-BID # FY 2019-2020-006 SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD SERVICES, TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER, WATERFIELD FLORIDA STAFFING LLC, DBA ACTION LABOR, DBA STAFFING CONNECTION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO EFFECTUATE THE SERVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, Hallandale Beach is home to many students who rely on walking as their primary method of commuting to and from school. As a result, children often must traverse busy Hallandale Beach Boulevard and Pembroke Road on their way to and from school; and

**WHEREAS**, providing crossing guard services is an essential and necessary service to help ensure the safety of school children; and

**WHEREAS**, July 8, 2020, the City released Re-Bid # FY 2019-2020-006, School Crossing Guard Services to provide school crossing guard services for the school children of the City Hallandale Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, the City sought responses from qualified and experienced firms and on July 16, 2020, the City held a non-mandatory pre-bid conference in which there were no vendor participation; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 5, 2020, the City received one (1) response from Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection; and

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40           **WHEREAS**, City Staff has determined that Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA  
41 Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection is the lowest responsible and responsive bid at  
42 sixty-one thousand one hundred and two dollars (\$61,102.00) for the first year and a total  
43 potential contract cost of three hundred five thousand five hundred and ten (\$305,510)  
44 dollars if the City exercises four optional renewals; and

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46           **WHEREAS**, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award  
47 Re-Bid # FY 2019-2020-006, School Crossing Guard Services, to the lowest responsive  
48 responsible bidder, Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing  
49 Connection, and to authorize the City Manager to negotiate an agreement to effectuate  
50 the service; and

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52           **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City  
53 Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

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56           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY**  
57 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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59           **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are adopted herein.

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61           **SECTION 2. City Commission Action.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby  
62 award Re-Bid # FY 2019-2020-006, School Crossing Guard Services, to the lowest  
63 responsive responsible bidder, Waterfield Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA  
64 Staffing Connection.

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66           **SECTION 3. City Manager's Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission  
67 hereby authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with Waterfield  
68 Florida Staffing, LLC, DBA Action Labor, DBA Staffing Connection in an amount not to  
69 exceed sixty-one thousand one hundred and two dollars (\$61,102.00) for the first year and  
70 a total potential contract cost of three hundred five thousand five hundred and ten  
71 (\$305,510) dollars if the City exercises four optional renewals, to be exercised at the City  
72 Manager's discretion. The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute all

73 related documents to effectuate this service.

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75 **SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon  
76 its passage and adoption.
