**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING  
THE CITY FEE BOOKLET RELATED TO PARKING FEES AND  
FINES AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC FEE PERMITS AND  
OTHER FEES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Article III, Section 10-61, of the City Code of Ordinances (the 'Code') , service or user charges or fees shall be set or amended by Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City Commission"); and

**WHEREAS**, on January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026, the City Commission considered and passed an ordinance amending the City Code, Article IV, Sec. 28-32. Stopping and parking prohibitions and restrictions, Sec. 28-54. Period of parking; disabled parking; parking overtime, and Sec. 28-73. Penalties; parking citation fines, to improve the City's ability to manage and enforce regulations within the public right-of-way, and provide the Parking Enforcement Unit with tools to better enforce parking violations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City enacted a fee structure for Maintenance of Traffic permit applications to cover the costs of plan review, inspections , and enforcement associated with work in the public right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the City's fee booklet containing fees and charges be amended to include the fees as detailed in Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach hereby approves the amendments to the City fee booklet to include the revised as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is authorized to promulgate and publish such fees and charges and shall ensure the proper collection and accounting of all monies arising therefrom.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
