17	WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,

Chapter 23, Section 23-4, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000, shall be based, wherever possible, on competitive bids; and

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WHEREAS, City staff recommends converting the existing tri-plex wet pit dry pump station located between the northeastern corner of the Gulfstream Racetrack and Golden Isles Park and Tennis Center on Layne Boulevard to a triplex submersible lift station, which project will include replacing and upgrading mechanical and electrical equipment and the existing emergency generator to improve system performance, increase system efficiency and reduce system maintenance; and

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30 WHEREAS, construction of Lift Station #1, also known as the Egret Tri-Plex 31 Submersible Lift Station, will ensure the needs of increased development intensity 32 are met, and will incorporate newer design standards granting easier access to the 33 controls, valves, and pumps to significantly reduce the time and personnel required 34 to perform regular maintenance, thereby reducing Operations and Maintenance 35 costs; and

WHEREAS, while the total originally budgeted amount for this project was
Three Million, Eight Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand, One Hundred and Forty Three Dollars (\$3,885,143), due to the current inflation costs of construction
materials, staff has requested additional funds in the amount of Two Million, Six
Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two Dollars and Ninety
Cents (\$2,692,932.90) to proceed with construction in the first FY 2022-2023
Budget Amendment; and
