4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION  
5 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,  
6 AUTHORIZING THE BROWARD COUNTY NATURESCAPE  
7 IRRIGATION SERVICE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR A  
8 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND,  
9 EIGHT HUNDRED, FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-  
10 FOUR CENTS (\$65,853.54); AND PROVIDING FOR AN  
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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14 **WHEREAS**, the NatureScape Irrigation Service (NIS) program provides site  
15 evaluations and tailored recommendations to improve water savings and water quality  
16 through enhancements in landscape and irrigation system design, maintenance, and  
17 operation, and has supported significant regional improvements in efficiency and measurable  
18 reductions in water use across both public and private properties; and  
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20 **WHEREAS**, in order to participate in the NIS and Residential Irrigation Rebate (RIR)  
21 Programs, the City Commission of Hallandale Beach must authorize an Interlocal Agreement  
22 with Broward County; and  
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24 **WHEREAS**, through an interlocal agreement, Broward County conducts a series of  
25 evaluations annually in coordination with the City of Hallandale Beach, which generally  
26 include both initial site assessments and follow-up visits on properties jointly selected by the  
27 City and the County focusing on City facilities, large commercial accounts, and multi-family  
28 residential properties; and  
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30 **WHEREAS**, the proposed interlocal agreement includes a base cost to the City of  
31 Nineteen Thousand, Seven Hundred, Thirty Dollars and Nine Cents (\$19,730.09) for the NIS  
32 Program and an optional Forty-Six Thousand, One Hundred, Twenty-Three Dollars and  
33 Forty-Five Cents (\$46,123.45) for the Residential Irrigation Rebate Program for a total  
34 maximum cost over the five (5) year period from November 5, 2025, through September  
35 30, 2030 of Sixty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred, Fifty-Three Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents  
36 (\$65,853.54); and

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38           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends the Mayor and City Commission authorize entering  
39 into a Broward County NatureScape Irrigation Service Interlocal Agreement for a base cost  
40 of Nineteen Thousand, Seven Hundred, Thirty Dollars and Nine Cents (\$19,730.09) for the  
41 NatureScape Irrigation Service (NIS) Program and an optional Forty-Six Thousand, One  
42 Hundred, Twenty-Three Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$46,123.45) for the Residential  
43 Irrigation Rebate Program (RIR) for a total maximum cost the City over the five (5) year period  
44 from November 5, 2025, through September 30, 2030, of Sixty-Five Thousand, Eight  
45 Hundred, Fifty-Three Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$65,853.54), and authorize the City  
46 Manager to execute relating documents.

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48           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
49 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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51           **SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated  
52 herein.

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54           **SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize  
55 entering into a Broward County NatureScape Irrigation Service Interlocal Agreement for a  
56 base cost of Nineteen Thousand, Seven Hundred, Thirty Dollars and Nine Cents (\$19,730.09)  
57 for the NatureScape Irrigation Service (NIS) Program and an optional Forty-Six Thousand,  
58 One Hundred, Twenty-Three Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$46,123.45) for the Residential  
59 Irrigation Rebate Program (RIR) for a total maximum cost the City over the five (5) year period  
60 from November 5, 2025, through September 30, 2030, of Sixty-Five Thousand, Eight  
61 Hundred, Fifty-Three Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$65,853.54), and authorize the City  
62 Manager to execute relating documents.

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64           **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its  
65 passage and adoption.
