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4 RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
6 AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE
7 PARK CONTRACT WITH BLUE LINE SOLUTIONS, LLC TO
8 PURCHASE HALLANDALE BEACH SCHOOL ZONE SPEED
9 CAMERA ENFORCEMENT AND COLLECTION SERVICES;
10 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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13 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-5, Competitive Procurement
14 Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services in
15 excess of the delegated spending authority, shall be based on a competitive procurement
16 process, and pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 26-9 (e), while the City Manager may award
17 procurements within the delegated spending authority, all other procurements, except
18 emergency procurements, require commission approval for award; and
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20 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section
21 23-5 Competitive procurement required; Procurement Mechanisms, Subsection (4)
22 Piggybacking, the City may procure goods or services from vendors who have been
23 selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another governmental entity if the
24 selection process utilized by the contracting entity was substantially similar to the
25 requirements of the City, and the goods or services procured by the City are procured
26 pursuant to the original contract scope and terms; and
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28 **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach solicited contracts pursuant to RFP No. FY
29 2024-2025-07, Speed Detection Camera System for School Zones, but was unable to
30 complete negotiations with the first ranked firm, Jenoptik Smart Mobility Solutions, LLC, and
31 with the second ranked firm, and Blue Line Solutions, LLC; and
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33 **WHEREAS**, in July of 2025, the Town of Pembroke Park awarded Town of Pembroke
34 Park RFP No. 12-473-14 contract to the above identified second ranked firm, Blue Line
35 Solutions, LLC, for similar speed detection camera services that closely align with the terms
36 sought by the City through its RFP (the "Source Agreement"); and

38 **WHEREAS**, consistent with Sec. 316.1896(5)(b), Fla. Stat. and the Source
39 Agreement, the Contractor performs collection activities for each \$100 ticket, retains its \$15
40 per ticket as its contractor fee, pays the City its \$45 per ticket (that must be used to administer
41 speed detection systems in school zones and other public safety initiatives pursuant to Sec.
42 316.1896(5)(b), F.S.), and transfers the balance collected per ticket to the City, after which
43 the City will forward from the balance transferred to it the following amounts required to be
44 transmitted to other agencies in accordance with the Source Agreement and applicable law:
45 a) \$20 State General Revenue Fund, b) \$12 local school district, c) \$3 DLE Criminal Justice
46 Standards and Training Trust Fund and d) \$5 retained by county or city for the School
47 Crossing Guard Recruitment and Retention Program; and
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49 **WHEREAS**, in exchange for the \$15 retained by Contractor for each ticket, Contractor
50 is responsible for all costs and services associated with the installation of the required
51 infrastructure, including equipment, cameras, and permits at all City locations, and will
52 manage the majority of the speed enforcement program including, without limitation, the
53 initiation of citations, mailing of required notices, and all collection activities.
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55 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the
56 public interest to authorize utilization of the Town of Pembroke Park RFP No. 12-473-14
57 contract with Blue Line Solutions, LLC to purchase Hallandale Beach school zone speed
58 camera enforcement and collection services, and authorize the City Manager to execute
59 relating documents.
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61 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
62 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**
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64 **SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated
65 herein.

66 **SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize
67 utilization of the Town of Pembroke Park RFP No. 12-473-14 contract with Blue Line
68 Solutions, LLC to purchase Hallandale Beach school zone speed camera enforcement and
69 collection services, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

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SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
