9 CONTRACTORS, INC. IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF
10 TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED,
11 FORTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$270,448.60)
12 TO CLEAN AND MAINTAIN LARGE-DIAMETER
13 STORMWATER PIPES, INCLUDING THE CITY'S 60-INCH
14 DIAMETER STORMWATER PIPE SPANNING NE 14TH
15 AVENUE FROM HALLANDALE BEACH BOULEVARD TO
16 ATLANTIC SHORES BOULEVARD; AND PROVIDING FOR
17 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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20 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 23-8 of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of
21 Ordinances, Exception to bid requirements, (6) Bids and contracts from other entities, and
22 Section 23-9. Cooperative purchasing, the City Manager may procure supplies, materials,
23 equipment and services from other governmental units, when the best interests of the City
24 would be served subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000 requires
25 City Commission approval; and
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27 **WHEREAS**, stormwater systems naturally accumulate sediment, silt, and debris as
28 part of their regular operation, which settle inside underground stormwater pipes and, over
29 time, diminish the system's hydraulic capacity, and while the City maintains a routine cleaning
30 program for small-diameter stormwater pipes (15 inches and under), it lacks both the
31 equipment and resources to service larger diameter pipes within the system; and
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33 **WHEREAS**, The City's 60-inch diameter stormwater pipe that spans NE 14th Avenue
34 from Hallandale Beach Boulevard to Atlantic Shores Boulevard plays a vital role in channeling
35 runoff away from residential and commercial areas, helping to preserve roadway access and
36 reduce flooding risks, and keeping this system functional is critical to stormwater system
37 performance, public safety, and regulatory compliance; and
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39 **WHEREAS**, Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. submitted a scope of work in
40 the amount of Two Hundred Seventy Thousand, Four Hundred, Forty-Eight Dollars and Sixty
41 Cents (\$270,448.60) proposing to utilize the competitively bid contract awarded by the City
42 of Fort Lauderdale under ITB No. 12504-613-5 to provide desilting, video inspection, and
43 condition assessment of the identified pipe segments, including temporary plugging and
44 bypass operations, mechanical desilting of accumulated debris, and closed-circuit television
45 (CCTV) inspection to document the condition of the pipe and identify any structural
46 deficiencies or necessary repairs; and

48 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the
49 public interest to authorize utilization of the City of Fort Lauderdale's competitively bid contract
50 ITB No. 12504-613-5 with Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. in a not to exceed
51 amount of Two Hundred Seventy Thousand, Four Hundred, Forty-Eight Dollars and Sixty
52 Cents (\$270,448.60) to clean and maintain large-diameter stormwater pipes, including the
53 City's 60-inch diameter stormwater pipe spanning NE 14th Avenue from Hallandale Beach
54 Boulevard to Atlantic Shores Boulevard, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating
55 documents.

58 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
59 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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61 **SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated
62 herein.

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64 **SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize
65 utilization of the City of Fort Lauderdale's competitively bid contract ITB No. 12504-613-5 with
66 Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. in a not to exceed amount of Two Hundred
67 Seventy Thousand, Four Hundred, Forty-Eight Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$270,448.60) to
68 clean and maintain large-diameter stormwater pipes, including the City's 60-inch diameter
69 stormwater pipe spanning NE 14th Avenue from Hallandale Beach Boulevard to Atlantic
70 Shores Boulevard, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
