EXHIBIT 1 RESOLUTION NO. 2025 -A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, FINDING UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. OF FORTY-SEVEN (47) AVIGILON CAMERAS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW) COMPLEX/CITY WATER PLANT FOR AN AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED. NINETY-TWO THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE **DOLLARS (\$192,561); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE** DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Section 23-8 (5), *Unique Circumstances*, of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances provides an exception to the competitive bidding requirement where the City Commission finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City; however, such purchases in excess of \$50,000.00 shall require a formal, written contract approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2023, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-032, citing unique circumstances to utilize the discount pricing from the Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for converting and maintaining the citywide CCTV system to Motorola's Avigilon platform due to compatibility with the Broward Sherrif's Office Real-Time Crime Center (RTCC); and

WHEREAS, under separate resolution coming before the City Commission on March 19, 2025, Staff is seeking approval for the originally planned Phase 1 of the Citywide Public Safety Program expansion by purchasing an additional fourteen (14) multisensor public safety cameras (each containing four cameras) and forty-eight (48) License Plate Recognition cameras, which purchase will also include a five-year warranty covering parts and a one-year warranty for labor, provided by Motorola Solutions, Inc., such cameras being fully compatible with the existing system, which is integrated with the RTCC for One Million, Two Hundred, Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty Three Dollars (\$1,295,443); and

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WHEREAS, in addition to the above, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public interest to leverage unique circumstances to expand the Citywide Public Safety Program by purchasing an additional forty-seven (47) Avigilon cameras for the Department of Public Works complex/City Water Plant, which purchase will also include a five-year warranty covering parts and a one-year warranty for labor, provided by Motorola Solutions, Inc., such cameras being fully compatible with the existing system, which is integrated with the RTCC for an amount of One Hundred, Ninety-Two Thousand, Five Hundred and Sixty-One Dollars (\$192,561) and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

 SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby find unique circumstances exist to authorize the purchase from Motorola Solutions, Inc. an additional forty-seven (47) Avigilon cameras for the Department of Public Works complex/City Water Plant, which purchase will also include a five-year warranty covering parts and a one-year warranty for labor, provided by Motorola Solutions, Inc., such cameras being fully compatible with the existing system, which is integrated with the Broward County Real Time Crime Center for an amount of One Hundred, Ninety-Two Thousand, Five Hundred and Sixty-One Dollars (\$192,561) and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
