






Figure 2: Turbo Methodology




Figure 1: Roles and Responsibilities

Seamlessly integrated into our enterprise resource planning (ERP) system, business processes for quotation (including self-quotation), order and invoice handling flow-down from these files. TOL also provides order confirmation including acknowledgment of the order, delivery date, tracking number and the order history on a per unit basis. This information is also secured and can only be accessed by a COHB Maintenance staff.



Furthermore, you can track total expenditures for reporting purposes. Each order source has its own six-digit identifier. Hence whether the order is input using the online ordering system or is directed to the Turbo Project Manager via email, phone or fax, the order is entered under that site code identifier. TOL includes a **tablet-based version** in which the device acts as a terminal that can be used in real-time inside the COHB maintenance facility. This includes the integrated capture of pictures and electronic signatures (much like the terminals used by the delivery agents of national couriers such as UPS, FedEx etc.)
