4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
5 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
6 AUTHORIZING CITY TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS
7 FOR GRANT PROGRAMS IDENTIFIED IN "EXHIBIT A" AS
8 PART OF THE CITYWIDE GRANT PROGRAM FOR 2025-26;
9 PROVIDING FOR ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT AWARD
10 AND EXECUTION OF ALL DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR
11 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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13 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01, of the City of Hallandale Beach
14 Charter, resolutions are to be presented to and adopted by a majority of the
15 Commission, and pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Grants Administrative
16 Policy, a resolution of the City Commission authorizing the approval and acceptance
17 of the grant application and/or award is required; and
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19 **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach Grants Division centralizes grants
20 management and grants development activities including accounting, compliance,
21 identification of grant opportunities, and coordination of City-wide applications; and
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23 **WHEREAS**, the City's grant matrix continues to be guided by opportunities made
24 available through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), enacted in 2021, which remains a
25 major source of federal investment through Fiscal Year 2026, and federal agencies are
26 actively releasing Notice of Funding Opportunities that align with the City's five-year CIP plan,
27 making BIL programs a central driver of the City's FY2025-26 grant strategy; and
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29 **WHEREAS**, this federal legislation emphasizes key investments in stormwater
30 infrastructure, provides funding for critical upgrades in cybersecurity and emergency
31 management systems, including modernized Emergency Operating Centers, and resources
32 are available for the procurement of essential police equipment, ensuring public safety
33 agencies are well-equipped to respond to evolving challenges; and
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35 **WHEREAS**, since its inception, the Division has secured approximately \$42
36 million in funding as of August 2025, and in recent years, has focused on strengthening

internal controls for compliance and building a long-term strategy for citywide grant development; and

WHEREAS, the window of time to prepare and submit grant applications is often short and may not allow for preparation of agenda items and presentation to the City Commission before submittal. Thus, to streamline and expedite the grant application process, staff requests authorization to prepare and submit grant proposals as identified in “Exhibit A”; and

WHEREAS, although most of the selected grant opportunities do not require a match, where a match is required above the City Manager’s delegated spending threshold, individual items will be brought back to the City Commission for authorization to accept the grant award and appropriate matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission deem it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to authorize City Administration to submit grant applications for grant programs as identified in “Exhibit A” attached hereto; and authorize approval of the FY 2025-26 Grant Proposal Matrix and provide advanced authorization for the City Manager or Executive Director to execute necessary documents for the submission and potential acceptance of pre-selected grant applications supporting citywide projects for Fiscal Year 2025-26.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. City Manager’s Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the submission of the grant applications for grant programs as identified in attached “Exhibit A” for Fiscal Year 2025-26; and authorize acceptance of grant application awards and the execution of any and all grant documents for awards requiring a match within the City Manager’s delegated spending threshold.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
