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WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach (City) owns, operates, and maintains a wastewater collection and transmission system including lift stations, monitoring systems, gravity sewers and force mains, collecting and pumping to the City of Hollywood's Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plan (SRWWTP) for treatment and disposal through metered connections; and

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WHEREAS, Staff desires to update the wastewater hydraulic model to reflect current and future conditions for use by its consulting engineers for refining pumps and force main selections; and,

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42 **WHEREAS,** further, to ensure that the City does not exceed its reserved 43 wastewater capacity with the City of Hollywood, the City is exploring the option of 44 conveying a portion of the wastewater to the south towards the Miami-Dade County 45 wastewater collection, transmission, and treatment systems; and

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WHEREAS, CCNA engineering firm Hazen and Sawyer has provided a
