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**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF THE NASPO CONTRACT
FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO REPLACE EXISTING
POLICE RADIOS WITH NEW MOTOROLA APX NEXT SMART
POLICE RADIOS FOR A TOTAL COST OF ONE MILLION,
EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS
(\$1,866,000); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-9, Award, (e), the City Manager may award procurements within the delegated spending authority, and all other procurements, except emergency procurements, require commission approval for award; and

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WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; Procurement Mechanisms, Subsection (3) Cooperative Purchasing, the City may procure goods or services through a variety of arrangements whereby two or more public entities have the opportunity to purchase from the same supplier or multiple suppliers using a single competitive procurement mechanism, and Subsection (4) Piggybacking, the City may procure goods or services from vendors who have been selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another governmental entity if the selection process utilized by the contracting entity was substantially similar to the requirements of the City, and the goods or services procured by the City are procured pursuant to the original contract scope and terms; and

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WHEREAS, in 2018, the City of Hallandale Beach City Commission adopted Resolution 2018-049 authorizing the City to enter into a Lease Purchase Agreement with Motorola Solutions to acquire one hundred and fifty (150) P25 Motorola radios, an acquisition that was necessary due to changes in the Broward County Regional Communication System that required all radios to be digital and capable of operating on the 700 MHz frequency; and

36 **WHEREAS**, the current P25 police radios are now eight years old, and their operating
37 system will no longer be supported by Motorola, and due to advancements in technology,
38 Motorola will cease providing spare parts for these radios after 2026, making future repairs
39 increasingly difficult or impossible; and

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41 **WHEREAS**, the new Motorola APX NEXT radios offer enhanced smart features,
42 including LTE wireless communication and advanced information-sharing capabilities, which
43 features significantly improve officer safety, particularly when operating inside condominium
44 buildings where traditional radio antenna signals are often limited or completely obstructed;
45 and

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47 **WHEREAS**, Staff proposes to enter into a purchase agreement with Motorola
48 Solutions to replace all existing police radios with one hundred and fifty (150) new Motorola
49 APX NEXT Smart Police Radios that are fully compatible with the County's existing radio
50 communication system and are integrated with the Broward County Real Time Crime Center
51 (RTCC), ensuring seamless coordination and enhanced communication capabilities across
52 law enforcement agencies; and

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54 **WHEREAS**, the proposed purchase agreement encompasses the radios, associated
55 hardware (to include belt holders and car chargers), programming, and warranty coverage
56 provided by Motorola Solutions, which includes Public Safety Software Services, accidental
57 damage insurance, and seven years of Smart Features and Central Services for a the total
58 cost of One Million, Eight Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$1,866,000), with the first-
59 year payment of One Million, Four Hundred, Forty-Five Thousand, Three Hundred and
60 Seventy Dollars (\$1,445,370) due that includes Equipment & Year 1 Deployment &
61 Subscription Services, after which there are six annual payments of Seventy Thousand, One
62 Hundred and Five Dollars (\$70,105) for the Public Safety Applications and DMS & Essential
63 Coverage with Accidental Damage ending in FY 2032 (the pricing reflects a one-time
64 Purchase Incentive discount of \$155,663 and a NASPO Contract #00318 as modified by a
65 Price Addendum for the State of Florida Discount totaling \$555,970); and

68 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the
69 public interest to utilize the NASPO Contract #00318 as modified by a Price Addendum for
70 the State of Florida to replace all existing police radios with one hundred and fifty (150) new
71 Motorola APX NEXT Smart Police Radios for a total cost of One Million, Eight Hundred Sixty-
72 Six Thousand Dollars (\$1,866,000), and authorize the City Manager to execute relating
73 documents.

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75 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
76 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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78 **SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated
79 herein.

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81 **SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize
82 utilization of the NASPO Contract #00318 as modified by a Price Addendum for the State of
83 Florida to replace all existing police radios with one hundred and fifty (150) new Motorola APX
84 NEXT Smart Police Radios for a total cost of One Million, Eight Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand
85 Dollars (\$1,866,000), and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

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87 **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
88 passage and adoption.
