



37           **WHEREAS**, on June 7, 2023, the City Commission authorized Change Order No. 1 in  
38 the amount of \$25,565 for Saltz Michelson Architects (SMA) to design the SW corner of the  
39 site where the transformer, switchgear and generator will be located; and  
40

41           **WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2023, the City Commission authorized Change Order  
42 No. 2 in the amount of \$245,467 for Saltz Michelson Architects (SMA) to provide for additional  
43 costs and credits; and  
44

45           **WHEREAS**, design firm Saltz Michelson Architects, Inc. has submitted a proposal for  
46 Change Order No. 3 to provide additional design services to break out a standalone Phase 1  
47 site construction document package for the EV Bus Charging and Maintenance Facility  
48 Project in the amount of \$48,355.56, plus the fee from TYLin (environmental engineers) of  
49 \$31,140.00, for a total sum of \$79,495.56, which includes an added fee for the preparation  
50 of a Soil Management Plan requested by the County to be used during construction for the  
51 safe removal, storage and final removal of contaminated material from the site to a certified  
52 facility; and

54           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the  
55 public interest to authorize Change Order No. 3 to the RFP# FY2021-2022-007, Consultants'  
56 Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) Design of Department of Public Works (DPW) Electric  
57 Vehicle (EV) Bus Charging and Fleet Facilities project agreement with Saltz Michelson  
58 Architects, Inc. in the amount of Seventy-Nine Thousand, Four Hundred, Ninety-Six Dollars  
59 (\$79,496), for a new total not to exceed design contract amount of One Million, Fifty  
60 Thousand, Two Hundred, Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$1,050,278), and authorize the City  
61 Manager to execute relating documents.
