RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE “2026 STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM”
AS ITS LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES; AUTHORIZING THE
LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM TO BE PRESENTED TO THE
BROWARD COUNTY STATE LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION
FOR CONSIDERATION DURING THE 2026 LEGISLATIVE
SESSION AND TO GIVE DIRECTION TO BALLARD
PARTNERS, INC. AS THEIR PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, annually, the City Commission discusses various issues for submittal
to the Broward County Legislative Delegation and State Legislators for consideration
during the legislative session; and

WHEREAS, as there are many issues that are significant to the City, it is imperative
to prioritize those issues that are most important and to focus its energy in ensuring the
constituent voices are heard at the County and State; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has reviewed prior priorities and the current
needs of the City and based on this year's discussions recommend that the Mayor and
City Commission adopt as the priorities for the City, to be presented to the Legislative
Delegation, as detailed in the attached “2026 State Legislative Program”; and

WHEREAS, these priorities serve to guide the City Commission, City
Administration, the City's lobbyist, and the legislators in pursuing legislation which
addresses these priorities and other related matters on behalf of the City and its residents;
and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the Mayor and City
Commission adopt the proposed City of Hallandale Beach's 2026 State Legislative
Program as its legislative priorities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses and referenced exhibits and
