2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING A UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCE AND AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF TEMPORARY STAFFING SERVICES FROM ROBERT HALF IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$200,000.00) DOLLARS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
11	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique
12	Circumstances, the City Commission may declare unique circumstances as an exception
13	to the requirements of competitive bidding; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, the City formerly utilized the NIGP SEFL Contract # 19-D-112F for the
16	procurement of temporary staffing services from Robert Half. However, the lead agency
17	and the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Group Cooperative did not renew
18	the contract as of June 30, 2022; and
19 20	WHEREAS, the Great Resignation continues to affect the City. As of the end of
21	August 2022, approximately 20% of City positions were vacant. The City needs to continue
22	to request temporary staffing to fill positions as needed for the remainder of the fiscal year.
23	Some of these positions may require specific expertise and uniquely qualified candidates
24	to provide immediate and effective assistance; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends authorizing the City Manager to
27	continue use of the temporary staffing services from Robert Half for FY 22/23.
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
29 20	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
30	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALL BLACH, I LONDA.
31 32	SECTION 1. Declaration of Unique Circumstances. The Mayor
33	and City Commission declare a Unique Circumstance pursuant to Chapter 23, Section
34	8(5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances.
35	
36	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission
37	hereby authorize the City Manager to continue to utilize Robert Half for temporary staffing
38	services for an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand (\$200,00.00) dollars as

39	provided for in fiscal year 2022-2023 budget, and authorize the City Manager to execute
40	all related documents to effectuate this purchase.
41 42	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
43	its passage and adoption.
