4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
5 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
6 WAIVING COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION REQUIREMENTS
7 AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE BROWARD SHERIFF'
8 OFFICE CONTRACT TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL
9 ADDITIONAL AVIGILON MULTI-SENSORS PUBLIC SAFETY
10 CAMERAS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT AT A COST OF
11 ONE MILLION, ONE HUNDRED, THIRTY-SEVEN
12 THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY-ONE DOLLARS
13 (\$1,137,241); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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15 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 23-10(4) of the City Code, "Exception to competitive
16 solicitation requirements," The City commission may waive competitive solicitation
17 requirements if it declares by majority vote that the process of competitive solicitations is not
18 in the best interest of the city and the reasons therefore; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Broward Sheriff's Office Real Time Crime Center (BSO RTCC)
21 exclusively utilizes the Avigilon Video Management System (VMS) alongside the Vigilant
22 License Plate Recognition (LPR) system. Therefore, integrating Hallandale Beach's citywide
23 camera system with the Avigilon VMS is essential for seamless and reliable footage sharing
24 with the RTCC. This integration significantly enhances the Hallandale Beach Police
25 Department's capabilities by enabling live monitoring of parolee ankle tags, providing live
26 access to school cameras which are critical during active shooter incidents, and granting
27 access to social media monitoring and other data collection tools; and

29 WHEREAS, on March 19, 2023, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2023-
30 032, citing unique circumstances to utilize the discount pricing from the Broward Sheriff's
31 Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for converting and maintaining
32 the citywide CCTV system to Motorola's Avigilon platform; and
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34 WHEREAS, on September 25, 2024, the City Commission adopted Resolution No.
35 2024-086, citing unique circumstances to utilize the discount pricing from the Broward

Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for installing twelve (12) Avigilon CCTV cameras from Motorola Solutions, Inc., in line with Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) standards, which mandate video surveillance for parked police vehicles, in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$32,415), including a five-year warranty on all parts and one year of labor; and

WHEREAS, in 2025, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2025-031, citing unique circumstances to utilize the discount pricing of Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS, in order to purchase and install an additional fourteen (14) multisensor public safety cameras (each containing four cameras) and forty-eight (48) LPR cameras for a cost for Phase 1 of the Citywide Public Safety Program of One Million, Two Hundred, Ninety-Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Forty Three Dollars (\$1,295,443), excluding the EV Bus Parking Lot and Water Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1, completed during FY2025, ensured that all city entry and exit points are covered by LPR cameras and added CCTV coverage to major traffic intersections within the city; and

WHEREAS, Phase 2, proposes to add thirty-seven (37) additional Avigilon multi-sensors and associated equipment funded through a combined contribution from the City and its Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA), with each entity providing Five Hundred, Sixty-Eight Thousand, Six Hundred, Twenty Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$568,620.50); and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the best interest of the City to waive competitive solicitation requirements and utilize the discount pricing of Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS, to purchase and install thirty-seven (37) additional Avigilon multi-sensors cameras and associated equipment at a cost of One Million, One Hundred, Thirty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred and Forty-One Dollars (\$1,137,241).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are confirmed as true and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby find it in the best interest of the City for the reasons stated herein to waive competitive solicitation requirements and utilize the discount pricing of Broward Sheriff's Office Contract # RLI 19053 JLS, to purchase and install thirty-seven (37) additional Avigilon multi-sensors cameras and associated equipment at a cost of One Million, One Hundred, Thirty-Seven Thousand, Two Hundred and Forty-One Dollars (\$1,137,241)., and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
