SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPOINTING COMMISSION MEMBERS AS CITY REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BROWARD LEAGUE OF CITIES, FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES, AND THE NATIONAL LEAGUE OF CITIES FOR THE 2026-2027 TERM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

The National League of Cities, Florida League of Cities, and Broward League of Cities are organizations composed of elected officials who advocate local priorities at the national (federal), state, and local levels, respectively. In addition, the organizations serve as forums for exchanging best practices and representing the City of Hallandale Beach's interests.

Annually, the City Commission appoints Directors, Voting Delegates, and/or Alternates to represent the City of Hallandale Beach on the Broward League of Cities, Florida League of Cities, and National League of Cities Board of Directors. These representatives serve annually.

Background:

In December 2024, the City Commission considered appointments of the voting delegates for the Broward League of Cities, Florida League of Cities, and National League of Cities for the 2024-2025 term. Accordingly, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2024-137 (Exhibit 2), designating the following voting members for the remainder of the year to represent the City:

Current Situation:

Any appointments made by the City Commission through the attached proposed Resolution (Exhibit 1) will take effect immediately for the 2026-2027 term.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to the Broward League of Cities' By-Laws, each City shall appoint a Director, Alternate, and Second Alternate to attend and vote at any Board of Directors or General Membership Meeting held where he/she represents his/her municipality.

Pursuant to the Florida League of Cities' By-Laws, each municipality shall appoint a Voting Delegate and an Alternate to attend and vote at the Annual Business Session.

Pursuant to the National League of Cities' By-Laws, each municipality shall appoint a Voting Delegate and up to two Alternates (if desired) to attend and vote at the Annual Business Meeting.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01 of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, a Resolution adopted by the Commission is an expression of the Commission on a provision for the disposition of a particular item of the administrative business of the governing body.

Cost-Benefit:

Although there is no fiscal impact beyond the payment of dues and travel to meetings as necessary, appointments to Broward, Florida, and the National League of Cities will ensure advocacy for local priorities and that the Cities' best interests are represented at the local, state, and national (federal) levels.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Staff recommends that the City Commission consider the attached Resolution.
