A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARDING BID # FY 2024-2025-04, 50TH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) NW 5TH TERRACE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER, WOLF CREEK CONSTRUCTION, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED, EIGHTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND SEVEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY DOLLARS (\$185,760.00) PLUS A TEN (10%) CONTINGENCY FOR A NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED, FOUR THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$204,336); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

This agenda item seeks City Commission's approval to award Bid # FY 2024-2025-04 50th Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) NW 5th Terrace Drainage Improvement Project, to Wolf Creek Construction LLC. as the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$185,760 plus a 10% contingency of (\$18,576) for a not-to-exceed amount of \$204,336 to complete the construction of the project.

Background:

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, managed by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), is a flexible program that provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community development needs. The City of Hallandale Beach received a funding award letter of \$150,805 by Broward County for the Public Works Improvement Project (Exhibit 2).

The 50th Year CDBG Public Works Improvement Project involves public works and utility infrastructure improvements including drainage improvements, sidewalks replacement, swell regrading and sodding. All work completed under this contract will occur within the City's right-of-way. The project improvements are at the following location (Exhibit 3):

Along NW 5th Terrace and NW 3rd Court
