CAUSLEY, LLC FOR CODE COMPLIANCE OFFICIAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR FY 2024-25 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$171,500); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16	WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach ("City") Code of Ordinances,		
17	Chapter 23, Sec. 23-8 (2), contracts for professional services involving peculiar skill, ability,		
18	experience or expertise, which are in their nature unique and not subject to competitive		
19	bidding, are exempt from competitive bidding requirements but require a formal written		
20	contract to be approved by the commission for all such contracts in excess of Twenty-Five		
21	Thousand Dollars (\$25,000); and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, the City's Code Compliance Official position within the Department of		
24	Sustainable Development (DSD) has been vacant since March 27, 2025, and DSD staff are		
25	actively recruiting for a full-time replacement hire; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, DSD has a current Professional Services Purchase Order (PO) of		
28	Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) in place with M.T. Causley to temporarily fill the		
29	Code Compliance Official position while it is vacant and a new employee is hired; and		
30			
31	WHEREAS, since the timeline to permanently fill the vacancy is uncertain, the		
32	department is proposing to increase the contract terms to provide services until the end of		
33	the fiscal year in the amount of one hundred twenty one thousand five hundred dolars		
34	(\$121,500) to ensure continuity of services, should the temporary position be needed beyond		
35	the current annual expenditure threshold; and		

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WHEREAS, taking the opportunity to assess the Code Compliance Division's effectiveness delivered in a comprehensive report known as Code Assessment Services to be prepared by the temporary Code Official. Staff is proposing to include Code Assessment Services, which provide as overview of the Code Division operations and recommendations for improvements, at an estimated cost of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000); and

**WHEREAS**, the consultant providing temporary continuing professional services is essential to maintaining the continuity of Code Compliance staff operations and will ensure a smooth transition when a permanent Code Compliance Official is hired; and

 WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission authorize an exception to competitive bidding requirement pursuant to Sec. 28-3 (2) professional services of the Code of Ordinances to approve the proposed contracts with M.T. Causley LLC for City Code Compliance Official professional services for FY 2024-25 in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventy One Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$171,500.00).

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** Recitals. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

 SECTION 2. Approval of Agreement and Authorization of City Manager. The Mayor and City Commission authorize the exception to the competitive bidding requirement under Sec. 28-3(2) of the Code of Ordinances, and hereby approve an increase to the annual allowable expenditure for City Code Compliance Official professional services with M.T. Causley LLC, including a Code Assessment Services Report, for an amount not to exceed in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventy One Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$171,500.00). The City Manager is further authorized to execute the agreements and related documents and to take such necessary action to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
