ORDINANCE NO. 2024-**

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**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 19, SECTION 19-1, "CAMPING AND OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC STREETS; PROHIBITED PUBLIC PLACES," OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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**WHEREAS**, during the 2024 legislative session the Florida Legislature enacted House Bill 1365, which prohibits counties or municipalities from authorizing or otherwise allowing "any person to regularly engage in public camping or sleeping on any public property, including, but not limited to, any public building or its grounds and any public right-of-way under the jurisdiction of the county or municipality"; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 8, 2024, Broward County passed an Ordinance to ban camping and sleeping in public in the areas under the jurisdiction of the County. This includes any municipality in the county that does not have a conflicting ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to lawfully prevent sleeping or camping in public areas to promote sanitation, public health and safety, in accordance with House Bill 1365 and Broward County Ordinance 2024-37; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the proposed amendments are in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** Section 19-1, "Camping and obstructing public streets; prohibited public

38 places” is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced as follows:  
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40 **Sec. 19.1. Public Camping or sleeping; prohibition; enforcement.**  
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42 (a) In accordance with Section 125.0231, Florida Statutes, it is the policy of the City to not  
43 authorize or otherwise allow any person to regularly engage in public camping or  
44 sleeping on any public property.  
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46 (b) It is the understanding and intent of the City Commission that references in the  
47 Broward County Code of Ordinances to “any public property under the jurisdiction of  
48 the County” include all public property owned, managed or controlled by the City for  
49 the purposes of enforcement of prohibitions of public camping or sleeping.  
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51 (c) Sworn law enforcement officers of the City shall enforce prohibitions of public camping  
52 or sleeping enacted by Broward County in the manner specified in the Broward County  
53 Code of Ordinances.  
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55 **SECTION 3. Conflict.** All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City  
56 of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the  
57 extent of such conflict.  
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59 **SECTION 4. Codification.** It is the intention of the Mayor and City Commission that  
60 the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such  
61 intention the words “ordinance” or “section” may be changed to other appropriate words.  
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63 **SECTION 5. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a  
64 court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the  
65 ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.  
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67 **SECTION 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
