14	WHEREAS, during the 2024 legislative session the Florida Legislature enacted House		
15	Bill 1365, which prohibits counties or municipalities from authorizing or otherwise allowing		
16	"any person to regularly engage in public camping or sleeping on any public property,		
17	including, but not limited to, any public building or its grounds and any public right-of-way		
18	under the jurisdiction of the county or municipality"; and		
19	WILEDEAG on Outshar 0, 2004 December 2004 on Outshar 2004		
20	WHEREAS, on October 8, 2024, Broward County passed an Ordinance to ban		
21	camping and sleeping in public in the areas under the jurisdiction of the County. This includes		
22	any municipality in the county that does not have a conflicting ordinance; and		
23 24	WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to lawfully prevent sleeping or camping in		
25	public areas to promote sanitation, public health and safety, in accordance with House Bill		
26	1365 and Broward County Ordinance 2024-37; and		
27 28	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the proposed		
29	amendments are in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents.		
30			
31	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION		
32	OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

34	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and		
35	incorporated herein.		
36			
37	SECTION 2. Section 19-1, "Camping and obstructing public streets; prohibited public		

places" is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced as follows: 38 39 Sec. 19.1. Public Camping or sleeping; prohibition; enforcement. 40 41 (a) In accordance with Section 125.0231, Florida Statutes, it is the policy of the City to not 42 authorize or otherwise allow any person to regularly engage in public camping or 43 sleeping on any public property. 44 45 (b) It is the understanding and intent of the City Commission that references in the 46 Broward County Code of Ordinances to "any public property under the jurisdiction of 47 the County" include all public property owned, managed or controlled by the City for 48 the purposes of enforcement of prohibitions of public camping or sleeping. 49 50 51 (c) Sworn law enforcement officers of the City shall enforce prohibitions of public camping or sleeping enacted by Broward County in the manner specified in the Broward County 52 Code of Ordinances. 53 54 **SECTION 3. Conflict.** All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City 55 56 of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the 57 extent of such conflict. 58 SECTION 4. Codification. It is the intention of the Mayor and City Commission that 59 60 the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate words. 61 62 63 **SECTION 5. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the 64 ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid. 65 66 **SECTION 6.
