SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING SETTLEMENT OF SUBROGATION CLAIM WITH OPTUM INSURANCE FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT, AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT TO RESOLVE PROPERTY DAMAGE CLAIMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

This case involves a claimant, Linda Panzarella who was traveling southbound on I-95 express lane nearing Hollywood Blvd exit when Officer Yanelis Valdes rear ended her. Police report and ARC place blame on city employee. The city has now received subrogation/reimbursement paperwork from the claimant's insurance company (Optum) in the amount of \$26,419.46, as the vehicle was a total loss.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Section 24-3 (d), the City of Hallandale Beach, Code of Ordinances, proposed settlements in excess of \$20,000 shall be submitted to the City Commission for its decision. This settlement exceeds the authority amount given to the City Manager, and City Attorney to settle claims, which require City Commission approval.
