# STAFF SUMMARY:

## **Summary:**

Staff is requesting that the City Commission consider the renewal of all Hallandale Beach nightclub licenses, which expire at 11:59 p.m. on September 30 of each year. The current Resolution authorizes the renewal of nightclub licenses for the attached list of nightclubs in Hallandale Beach.

## **Background:**

Pursuant to Section 5-9 of the City's Code of Ordinances, annual nightclub licenses will be considered by the City Commission. Such approval may be made by Resolution. All relevant code sections referenced in this agenda cover memo are attached (Exhibit 2).

On August 7, 2024, the City Commission considered the renewal of Nightclub Licenses for FY 23-24 for seven (7) establishments.

For FY 24-25, seven (7) establishments are being considered for the annual Nightclub License renewal as listed below. There were no objections regarding the renewals, as the deficiencies reported were not significant enough to preclude the renewal of the licenses.

#### **Current Situation:**

Licenses to sell alcoholic beverages are issued by the State of Florida; however, the regulation of hours for the sale of alcoholic beverages falls under the jurisdiction of the City of Hallandale Beach. Section 5-4(a) of the Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on weekdays and Saturdays, and between 2:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Sundays, unless the establishment has been issued a nightclub license and/or special permit by the City.

The criteria for the issuance and renewal of nightclub licenses, as outlined in Section 5-9 of the Code of Ordinances, include but are not limited to:

- The amount of available off-street parking;
- The amount and degree of law enforcement activity generated by the extended hours of operation;
- Any adverse impacts the operation may have on neighboring properties.

Listed below are the results of inspections and reviews conducted by the Hallandale Beach Police Department, Fire Rescue (Broward Sheriff's Office), and the Department of Sustainable

Development (Building, Code Compliance, and Planning & Zoning Divisions) for the seven (7) establishments seeking renewal of their nightclub licenses.

Police Department - No Objection, subject to conditions of approval

Incidents attached as Exhibit 3)

Fire Rescue - No Objection

DSD Building Division - No Objection, subject to conditions of approval

DSD Planning & Zoning Division - No Objection

DSD Code Compliance Division - No Objection, subject to conditions of approval

#### Why Action is Necessary:

Section 5-9(d) of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances states that all nightclub licenses expire at 11:59 p.m. on September 30 of each year, and the City Commission is required to consider renewal of these licenses.

Such renewal may be made by Resolution. Pursuant to Section 5.01 of the City Charter, the approval of a Resolution can only be made by the City Commission.

## **Cost Benefit:**

Approval of the nightclub renewals for FY 24-25 would generate approximately \$64,080 in revenues.
