SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE THREE ISLANDS SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH APPROVING AMENDED BUDGET FOR THE THREE ISLANDS SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICT FOR THE 2024 - 2025 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

The proposed resolution is to amend the FY 2024-25 Budget to account for unanticipated expenditures for the current Fiscal Year based on mission critical items identified after the budget was adopted, and to account for necessary adjustments as part of the end-of-year (EOY) process. Amending the adopted budget will increase the Fund by \$1,100,000.

Background:

On September 25, 2024, the City Commission adopted the FY 2024-25 Budget in the amount of \$575,226.

The Three Islands Guardhouse and Traffic Calming Project is a planned neighborhood security and traffic calming improvement within the Three Islands Safe Neighborhood District (TISND). On June 4, 2025, the City Commission approved a budget amendment appropriating \$4.6 million from the General Fund to the TISND Fund to advance project design, permitting, and procurement. A special assessment was levied on June 18, 2025, establishing the recovery of \$3.5 million in project costs from benefiting properties in accordance with the adopted assessment methodology.

The project was bid on August 18, 2025, and the construction contract was awarded on October 22, 2025, following final cost reconciliation confirming a total project cost of approximately \$5.43 million, inclusive of construction and contingency. To complete the project's funding plan, the District is responsible for a \$1.1 million contribution from available TISND fund balance reserves.

Current Situation:

This budget amendment formally establishes the appropriation within the Three Islands Safe Neighborhood District Fund necessary to provide the District's share of the project funding:

<u>120 | Three Islands Neighborhood District</u> – Budget Increase – \$1,100,000

1. Three Islands - Budget Increase - \$1,100,000

The General Fund initially advanced \$4.6 million to the Three Islands Safe Neighborhood District (TISND) Fund in anticipation of the project. The total project cost is \$5,434,140, of which \$3.5 million will be recovered through a special assessment, \$1.1 million will be reimbursed to the General Fund using TISND fund balance reserves, while the remaining \$834,140 will be funded from General Fund fund balance reserves.

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Why Action is Necessary:

Florida Statutes require a local governmental unit to amend its adopted budget anytime during the fiscal year or within sixty (60) days after the end of the fiscal year for which the budget applied.

Cost Benefit:

The proposed budget amendment will increase the FY 2024-25 Budget for the TISND by an amount not-to-exceed \$1,100,000. This amendment will allow staff to continue to provide additional community services and ensure public safety.
